

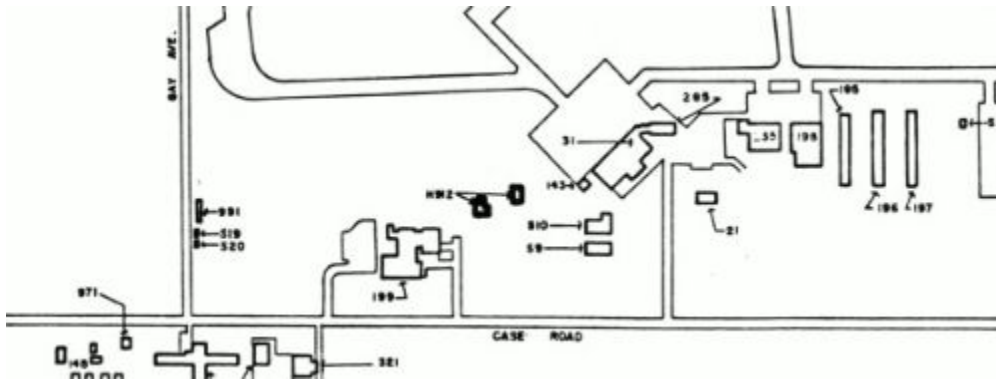
# Garner House and Barn

Herrick Archives Number H 912

These two buildings appear on the plot plan for the construction of the first unit of the Hangar Building at the airport (Building 031). They were on the property when it was acquired by the University.

This property was acquired by warranty deed executed October 22, 1942 by Gertrude M. Garner (Deeds Book 1196, p. 480). The deed gave the grantor the right to remove the buildings within 30 days.

See Addendum No. 2

This plot plan on which these two buildings appear is dated October 1942, which is the month during which the property was acquired.

No effort has been made to determine whether the buildings were actually removed by the grantor or were removed later by the University.

A note on Map 194-15 (First Stage, Unit 1) proposed to remodel the house into a flight building. This map was prepared in October 1942. The deed, which was executed October 22, 1942, gave the grantors the right to remove the buildings within 30 days.

If Part B of the report on H 909 is correct, the house was not used as a flight building.
