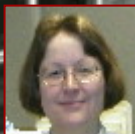

Fulbright Scholar Comes to Hilandar



Professor Yulia Artamonova of Moscow, Russia, has been awarded an eight-month Fulbright Scholarship to conduct research in the Hilandar Research Library (227 Main Library). Professor Artamonova arrived in early January 2004 to begin work on her project "Hymnographic Models from South Slavonic and Old Russian manuscripts."

Yulia Artamonova is a graduate of the Department of History and Theory of Music of the State Musical and Pedagogical Institute (Moscow, Russia, 1989). Her master's thesis examined Old-Russian chants. She received her PhD from the same institute (now re-named Gnossins' Russian Academy of Music). Her thesis is entitled 'Hymnographic models in Old Russian Church Musical Culture of the 11th to the 18th centuries'.

Professor Artamonova worked as a lecturer in the RAM for almost ten years (1992-2001) and now works as a research fellow for the Research Center of the Traditional Culture - affiliated with her home institution (RAM). Her research interests include Old Slavonic musical culture and hymnography, manuscripts and notations and the performance of Old Russian chants.

Featuring alum and author, Dr. Charles K. Ross, Assistant Professor of Afro-American Studies and History at the University of Mississippi. Dr. Ross received his Masters degrees at Ohio State in African American Studies and History and his Ph.D. in History. He will be reading from his recent book, *Outside the Lines: African Americans and the Integration of the National Football League*. In this chronicle of black NFL athletes, Dr. Ross highlights the story of the 'Jackie Robinsons' of American football.

A celebrity panel, moderated by Mike Valpredo of WCMH-Channel 4, will discuss contemporary issues relating to African-Americans and minorities in sports (i.e. college and professional opportunities in coaching, athletic director positions, ownership, etc.). Panelists include Professor Melvin Adelman (Sports Education at OSU), Dr. William E. Nelson (Black Studies Dept.), Ben Espy (former OSU Football player and city councilman, state senator, and attorney), Stephanie Hightower (former world class track athlete, current president of Columbus School Board, and special assistant to Mayor Greg Lashutka), and Jessica Johnson, OSU alum and local journalist.

The panel discussion will be followed by a book signing with Dr. Ross and reception in the Ohio Union Lounge.

Rocki Strader Wins Carol June Bradley Award

Rocki Strader travels this month to Washington, DC to become the first recipient of the Carol June Bradley Award for Historical Research in Music Librarianship. Initially announced at the 2003 Music Library Association annual meeting, this award was established in honor of Carol June Bradley, Librarian Emeritus at the State University of New York at Buffalo. The award, in the amount of \$1,000, is granted to support research that involves the history of music libraries or special collections; biographies of music librarians; studies of specific aspects of music librarianship; and studies of music library patrons' activities.



Rocki submitted a proposal on the History of Cataloging of Sound Recordings in the United States. Her research will include a chronology of developments in the cataloging of recordings, development of the MARC format as related to sound recordings, and an annotated bibliography from 1981 to 2000/01. Rocki will be traveling this year to the University of Maryland to the Archives of the Music Library Association. Her time will be spent reviewing correspondence, working documents, and official statements related to her research.

Within the year, Rocki will submit a report of her research and expenses to the Music Library Association and hopes to publish the results of the first part of her research. She is honored to be the first recipient of this award and looks forward to meeting with Dr. Bradley at the conference in Washington.
