Final Highlights of Enrollment for the Summer Quarter of 2003

August 14, 2003

Summer Quarter 2003 began June 23, 2003. A census for the quarter was conducted as of the close of processing on August 11th. The fifteenth day census is the basis for these highlights and the supporting data contained herein.

- An overall decrease in enrollment of 129 compared to Summer Quarter of 2002 was recorded for this quarter. Increases were experienced at Columbus (up 90 to 19,759; 0.5%) and Marion (up 13 to 456; 2.9%) while the remaining regional campuses had decreases in enrollment compared to Summer Quarter 2002. Those decreases were: Lima (down 114 to 467; -19.6%), Mansfield (down 40 to 432; -8.5%), Newark (down 63 to 658; -8.7%) and Wooster (down 15 to 203; -6.9%). [Table 1].
- Undergraduate enrollment (down 70 to 13,057; -0.5%) and graduate enrollment (down 115 to 7,863; -1.4%) decreased while graduate professional enrollment (up 56 to 1,055; 5.6%) increased. New first quarter freshman (up 51 to 204 (33.3%) and transfer students above Rank 2 (up 9 to 619 (1.5%) experienced increases while the remaining sources decreased. New to OSU graduate students are up 14 to 532 (2.7%), New from OSU graduate students are down 60 to 600 (-9.1%), Continuing students are up 19 to 5,897 (0.3%) and former graduate students are down 88 to 834 (-9.5%). - Eight undergraduate curricular academic programs recorded enrollment shifts of more than fifteen percent compared to last year. These are Arts and Sciences, General (down 45 to 155; -22.5%), Arts and Sciences, Unknown (down 29 to 46; -38.7%), Journalism (up 16 to 94; 20.5%), Education, up 35 to 244 (16.7%), Food, Agricultural, and Environmental Sciences (down 50 to 252; -16.6%), Nursing (up 24 to 79; 43.6%), Pharmacy (down 17 to 89; -16.0%) and Social Work (up 7 to 18; 63.6%). Graduate programs with changes in excess of fifteen percent are: Human Ecology (down 16 to 72; -18.2%), Allied Medical Professions (up 39 to 167; 30.5%) and Social Work (up 26 to 190; 15.9%). The graduate professional program recording a change in excess of fifteen percent was Pharmacy (up 19 to 23; 475.0%) [Table 3].
- Credits generated by full time undergraduates at Columbus increased 5.3% (to 72,797) and the extended campuses increased as a whole 2.8% (to 8,001). The total increase in full-time undergraduate credit hours was 3,900, up 5.1% from the Summer of 2002. Overall, part-time credit hours decreased (down 1,536 to 51,614; -2.9%). Both the Columbus campus (-2.4%) and the extended campuses (-5.2%) experienced a decrease in total part-time credit hours. Overall, the total number of credit hours increased 2,364 to 132,412 (up 1.8%) and the credits per student also increased to 10.14 (up 0.23; 2.4%). Although there was a decrease in the number of graduate students, the number of total graduate credit hours increased 355 to 76,470 (0.5%). Full-time graduate credit hours increased 3.0% to 54,405 on the Columbus campus and decreased 26.2% to 989 on the extended campuses as a whole, thus resulting in an overall full-time graduate credit hour increase of 2.2% to 55,394. Graduate credits per student for the entire university were up 0.18 to 9.73 (1.9%). Graduate professional credit hours were up 959 to 14,500, (7.1%) and credits per student were up 1.4% to 13.74. Undergraduate FTE increased from 8,670 from Summer 2002 to 8,827. Graduate professional FTE increased from 903 to 967. Graduate FTE increased to 5,098 from 5,074. [Table 4]

- For the total university, fourteen counties recorded enrollment changes (positive or negative) in excess of twenty percent from last Summer; Athens (up 59.3%), Erie (up 22.1%), Fayette (down 39.6%), Gallia (down 41.2%), Harrison (down 41.7%), Hocking (up 50.0%), Morgan (up 66.7%), Ottawa (down 35.0%), Paulding (up 41.7%), Ross (up 45.5%), Seneca (down 28.3%), Trumbull (down 20.4%), Tuscarawas (up 21.1%) and Vinton (down 57.1%). For the Columbus campus, eighteen counties recorded enrollment changes in excess of twenty percent: Athens (up 55.6%), Crawford (up 26.7%), Erie (up 33.8%), Fayette (down 41.3%), Gallia (down 47.1%), Harrison (down 58.3%), Hocking (up 50.0%), Holmes (down 31.3%), Marion (up 23.9%), Morgan (up 166.7%), Ottawa (down 34.2%), Paulding (up 333.3%), Perry (up 36.8%), Preble (up 38.5%), Ross (up 50.0%), Seneca (down 23.6%), Trumbull (down 21.3%) and Vinton (down 50.0%). - For the total university, the states and territories with enrollment that changed in excess of twenty percent from last Summer were: Alaska (up 100.0%), Arkansas (down 21.4%), Connecticut (up 23.1%), District of Columbia (up 42.9%), Guam (down 100.0%), Idaho (up 57.1%), Mississippi (up 22.2%), Montana (up 33.3%), Nebraska (down 42.1%), Nevada (up 50.0%), New Hampshire (down 66.7%), North Dakota (down 50.0%), Rhode Island (up 71.4%), South Dakota (down 25.0%), Vermont (up 125.0%), Virgin Islands (down 50.0%), Washington (down 25.0%), and Wyoming (up 33.3%). At Columbus, the states and territories with enrollment that increased or decreased in excess of twenty percent from last Summer were: Alaska (up 100.0%), Connecticut (up 23.1%), District of Columbia (up 42.9%), Guam (down 100.0%), Idaho (up 57.1%), Mississippi (up 22.2%), Montana (up 33.3%), Nebraska (down 38.9%), Nevada (up 50.0%), New Hampshire (down 66.7%), North Dakota (down 50.0%), Rhode Island (up 71.4%), South Dakota (down 25.0%), Vermont (up 75.0%), Virgin Islands (down 50.0%), Washington (down 25.0%), and Wyoming (up 33.3%) [Table 7 and Table 8]
- Of the twenty-five countries with the largest representation of students enrolled at Ohio State, Malaysia (up 108.3%), Thailand (down 20.6%), Pakistan (up 26.7%), Russia (down 30.8%), Argentina (up 55.6%), and Egypt (up 40.0%) recorded changes in enrollment in excess of twenty percent from last Summer Quarter. People's Republic of China, India, Republic of Korea, Taiwan, Indonesia and Japan recorded enrollment of 100 or more students this quarter. [Table 9]
- Continuing Education had an international enrollment of 8.3 percent. Undergraduate curricular academic programs with international student enrollment in excess of five percent were Business (15.9%), Engineering (13.7%), and Architecture (10.1%). Forty percent or more of the graduate students in Biological Sciences (48.2%), Mathematical and Physical Sciences (50.4%), Engineering (68.4%), Food, Agricultural and Environmental Sciences (45.8%), and Pharmacy (66.3%) were international students. International graduate student enrollment at Columbus was 1,988 and the total university was 1,992. International graduate professional student enrollment was 4. [Table 10]
- Summer Quarter record high enrollments among African Americans (1,662) total and Hispanics (383 total) were reached this quarter. [Tables 11, 12, and 13]
- At the undergraduate level, enrollment of Ohio residents decreased 0.8% (down 91 to 11,647) while enrollment of not-Ohio residents increased 1.5% (up 21 to 1,410). Graduate enrollment of Ohio residents decreased (down 24 to 4,738; -0.5%) and not-Ohio residents decreased (down 91 to 3,125; -2.8%). Graduate professional enrollment of Ohio residents increased 79 to 1,024 (up 8.4%) and not-Ohio residents decreased 23 to 31 (down 42.6%). [Table 14]
- Record high enrollment of 533 female Graduate Professional students was reached this Summer Quarter. [Tables 11 and Table 16]
