Final Highlights of Enrollment for the Winter Quarter of 2007

January 24, 2007

Winter Quarter 2007 began on January 3, 2007. An official census for the quarter was conducted as of the close of processing on January 22nd. The fifteenth day census is the basis for these highlights and the supporting data contained herein.

- An overall increase in enrollment of 1,472 students compared to Winter Quarter 2006 was reported this quarter for a total of 57,435. Four campuses experienced increases in enrollment: Columbus (up 1,282 to 50,366; 2.6%), Lima (up 74 to 1,187; 6.6%), Marion (up 10 to 1,506; 0.7%), and Newark (up 169 to 2,209; 8.3%), while the remaining two campuses experienced a decrease: Mansfield (down 18 to 1,465; -1.2%) and Wooster (down 45 to 702; -6.0%). [Table 1]

- Undergraduate, Graduate and Graduate Professional student enrollment experienced increases compared to Winter Quarter 2006. Undergraduate enrollment increased by 1,376 to 44,145; (3.2%), Graduate Professional enrollment increased by 1 to 3,253 (0.0%) and Graduate enrollment increased by 95 to 10,037 (1.0%). As a whole, all sources of undergraduate enrollment increased; new first-quarter freshmen (up 10 to 283; 3.7%), transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (up 52 to 615; 9.2%), transfer students above Rank 2 (up 119 to 681; 21.2%), continuing students (up 1,139 to 41,385; 2.8%) and returning students (up 56 to 1,181; 5.0%). Three sources of undergraduate enrollment at the extended campuses increased: new first quarter freshmen (up 3 to 192, 1.6%), continuing students (up 169 to 5,925; 2.9%), and returning students (up 65 to 363; 21.8%). The remaining source categories at the extended campuses experienced decreases in enrollment: transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (down 1 to 92; -1.1%), and transfer students above Rank 2 (down 14 to 142; -9.0%). At the Columbus campus all but one of the undergraduate source categories recorded increases. The undergraduate source category that experienced a decrease was returning students (down 9 to 818; -1.1%). The remaining source categories at the Columbus campus experienced increases in enrollment: new first quarter freshmen (up 7 to 91, 8.3%), transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (up 53 to 523, 11.3%), transfer students above Rank 2 (up 133 to 539; 32.8%), and continuing students (up 970 to 35,460; 2.8%). Graduate student enrollment at the Columbus campus for Winter 2007 was greater than Winter 2006; an increase of 127 to 9,682 (1.3%) was reported. Enrollment of graduate students at all extended campuses was down 32 to 355; (-8.3%). Overall, enrollment of new graduate students was down 50 to 352 (-12.4%). Enrollment of continuing graduate students increased (up 155 to 9,159; 1.7%) while returning students decreased (down 10 to 526; -1.9%). As a result, enrollment of graduate students as a whole was up 95 to 10,037 (1.0%). Enrollment of graduate professional students was up 1 to 3,253 (0.0%). [Table 2].

- Seven undergraduate curricular academic programs at the Columbus campus saw an increase in enrollment from Winter 2006 in an excess of ten percent; these programs include Arts and Sciences, General (up 273 to 1,187; 29.9%), Earth Sciences (up 19 to 63; 43.2%), Continuing Education (up 149 to 975; 18.0%), Dentistry: Dental Hygiene (up 18 to 176; 11.4%), Nursing (up 97 to 966; 11.2%), Pharmacy (up 68 to 484; 16.3%) and Undergraduate Student Academic Services (up 114 to 223; 104.6%). Two undergraduate curricular academic programs at the Columbus campus decreased in an excess of ten percent in enrollment from Winter 2006; these were Arts and Sciences, Unknown (down 5 to 40; -11.1%) and Exploration Program (down 518 to 2,627; -16.5%). Graduate level programs reporting changes (positive or negative) in excess of ten percent were: Earth Sciences (up 6 to 52; 13.0%), Environment and Natural Resources (up 8 to 74; 12.1%), Medicine: Allied Medical Professions (up 28 to 236; 13.5%), Nursing (up 37 to 286; 14.9%), Public Affairs (down 10 to 88; -10.2%), Public Health (up 41 to 274; 17.6%), Social Work (up 43 to 459; 10.3%), the graduate program in Law (down 1 to 0; 100%), and the graduate program in Medicine (up 27 to 166; 19.4%). [Table 3]
- Credits generated by full-time undergraduates increased at the Columbus campus (up 18,963 to 545,000; 3.6%) and at the extended campuses (up 3,257 to 82,063; 4.1%). The result was an overall increase of 22,220 to 627,063 (3.7%) from Winter Quarter 2006. Credits for part-time students decreased in total (down 480 to 36,334, -1.3%). While at the extended campuses credits generated by part-time students increased (up 117 to 10,293; 1.1%), credits generated by part-time undergraduates at Columbus was down 597 to 26,041 (-2.2%). Total credits generated by undergraduates for the entire university increased 21,740 to 663,397 (3.4%). With the total credit hours at the undergraduate level for the university increasing, credits per student increased as well (up 0.02 to 15.03, 0.2%) compared to Winter 2006. At the graduate level, there was an overall increase in credits (up 2,850 to 117,489; 2.5%); at the Columbus campus an increase in credits was reported (up 3,063 to 114,256; 2.8%) while the extended campuses as a whole reported a decrease (down 213 to 3,233; -6.2%). Graduate credits per student for the entire university were up 1.5% with 11.71 credits per student. Graduate professional credits per student were down 1.1% while total credits also decreased (down 640 to 58,342; -1.1%). Undergraduate full time equivalents (FTE) increased from 42,777 to 44,226. Graduate professional FTE decreased from 3,932 to 3,889. Graduate FTE decreased from 7,643 to 7,833. [Table 4]
- For the total university, the following counties reported enrollment changes in excess of twenty percent (positive or negative) from last winter; Adams (up 27.8%), Darke (up 23.5%), Hocking (up 21.2%), Jackson (up 39.1%), Morgan (down 26.1%), Preble (up 34.0%) and Scioto (up 22.3%). For the Columbus campus, the counties which recorded enrollment changes in excess of twenty percent were Darke (up 22.4%), Harrison (up 35.0%), Hocking (up 23.7%), Jackson (up 37.8%), Morgan (down 21.1%), and Preble (up 23.8%). [Table 5 and Table 6]
- For the total university, the states and territories with enrollment that changed in excess of twenty percent from last Winter were: South Carolina (up 31.8%), District of Columbia (up 27.8%), Oklahoma (up 24.2%), Nevada (up 47.1%), North Dakota (down 25.0%), South Dakota (up 80.0%) and Guam (down 100.0%). At Columbus, the states and territories with enrollment that increased or decreased in excess of twenty percent from last Winter were: South Carolina (up 31.8%), District of Columbia (up 27.8%), Oklahoma (up 25.0%), Nevada (up 47.1%), North Dakota (down 25.0%), South Dakota (up 80.0%) and Guam (down 100.0%). Highlights

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- Of the twenty-five countries with the largest representation of students enrolled at Ohio State, Indonesia (down 31.8%), Malaysia (down 26.9%), Saudi Arabia (up 122.2%), Jamaica (up 188.9%), Romania (down 31.0%) and England (down 28.0), reported changes in enrollment in excess of twenty percent from last Winter Quarter. People's Republic of China, Republic of Korea, India, Taiwan, Japan, Turkey and Indonesia recorded enrollment of 100 or more students this quarter. [Table 9]
- Continuing Education had an international enrollment of 10.7%; this is up from 9.4% last Winter. Business also had an international student enrollment in excess of five percent (6.4%). International student enrollment was recorded at 3,458 for the total university and 3,445 on the Columbus campus. There are several graduate programs in which forty percent or more of students enrolled were international students; these programs included: Biological Sciences (46.9%), Mathematical and Physical Sciences (46.6%), Engineering (57.1%), Food, Agriculture, and Environmental Sciences (46.8%) and Pharmacy (55.2%). [Table 10]
- At the undergraduate level, both enrollment of Ohio residents (up 1,298 to 39,880; 3.4%) and non-Ohio residents (up 78 to 4,265; 1.9%) increased. Similarly, graduate enrollment of Ohio residents (up 77 to 5,858; 1.3%) and non-Ohio residents (up 18 to 4,179; 0.4%). Graduate professional enrollment of Ohio residents decreased (down 47 to 2,902, -1.6%) while non-Ohio residents (up 48 to 351; 15.8%) increased this quarter. [Table 14]
- Winter Quarter 2007 reported record high enrollment for undergraduate female students (21,282), total female students (28,666), American Indian or Alaskan Native students (240), Asian or Pacific Islander students (2,832) and Hispanic students (1,295).
