Description of Frontispiece

This map, used as a frontispiece, is reproduced through the courtesy of Howard Dwight Smith, the University Architect. It shows the general plans for campus improvements. Of special note are the dormitories at corner of Eleventh and High (lower right corner), the auditorium to the north of these dorms, the change of the Engineering Quadrangle as described in the article, the replacement of Lord Hall, completion of Brown Hall, the library addition, and straightening the oval. The new armory is now being built just to the west of its location on this map north of Woodruff.

The man on the cover is one of Ohio State's most popular additions to its faculty—Mr. Paul Brown, Head Football Coach.
