### 1. Name

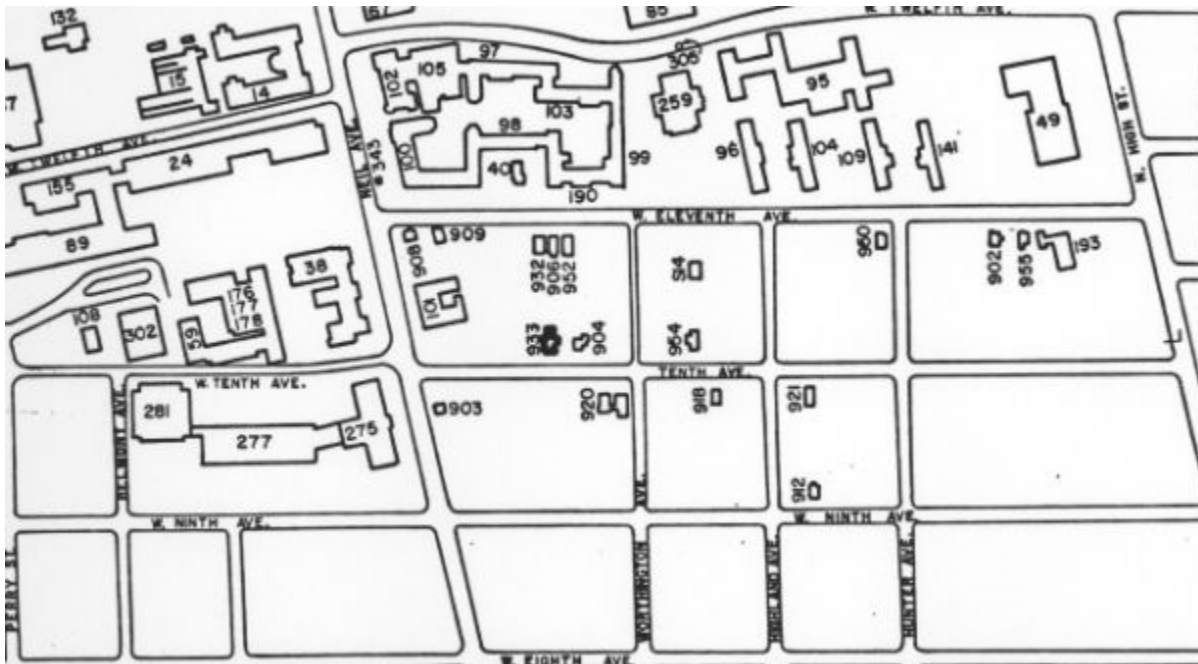
1.1 Never officially named by Board of Trustees.

3.1 Type of construction:

Brick with wood interior.

3.2 No. of stories:

Basement and three stories.

3.3 Increments of construction:

No additions since acquisition by University.

3.4 Present area of building as shown in inventory records of Division of Campus Planning:

5592 sq. ft. gross; 2373 sq. ft. net assignable

3.5 A 1963 appraisal report stated that the building was 68+ years old.

### **B. ACQUISITION**

Title conveyed to University by warranty deed executed July 27, 1972 (Deed book 3260, page 492).

### **C. USE**

Currently used for temporary offices during remodeling of Page (061), Hagerty (037), Derby (025), and Administration Building (001).

Earlier used as research offices by Education and Administrative Science.
