B. PLANNING & CONSTRUCTION

1. On March 11, 1965 the Board of Trustees approved the plans and related documents prepared by Freshwater, Harrison & Associates and authorized the solicitation of bids by contractors.

2. Bids were received on May 3, 1965.

3. On May 13, 1965 the Board of Trustees awarded contracts to the following contractors:

General: E. J. Will & Co.

Electrical: Gustav Hirsch Organization, Inc.

Heating & ventilating: Capitol Refrigeration System

Plumbing: Wuellner & Theado

4. Completion and occupancy:

A progress report in the University Architect's files (Project A6445) indicates that the project was 99% complete on December 20, 1965. The general and plumbing contracts were accepted on December 1, 1965; the heating and ventilating and electrical contracts, on February 17, 1966 (A).
