Erroneously carried on some Campus Planning records as Agronomy Shop.

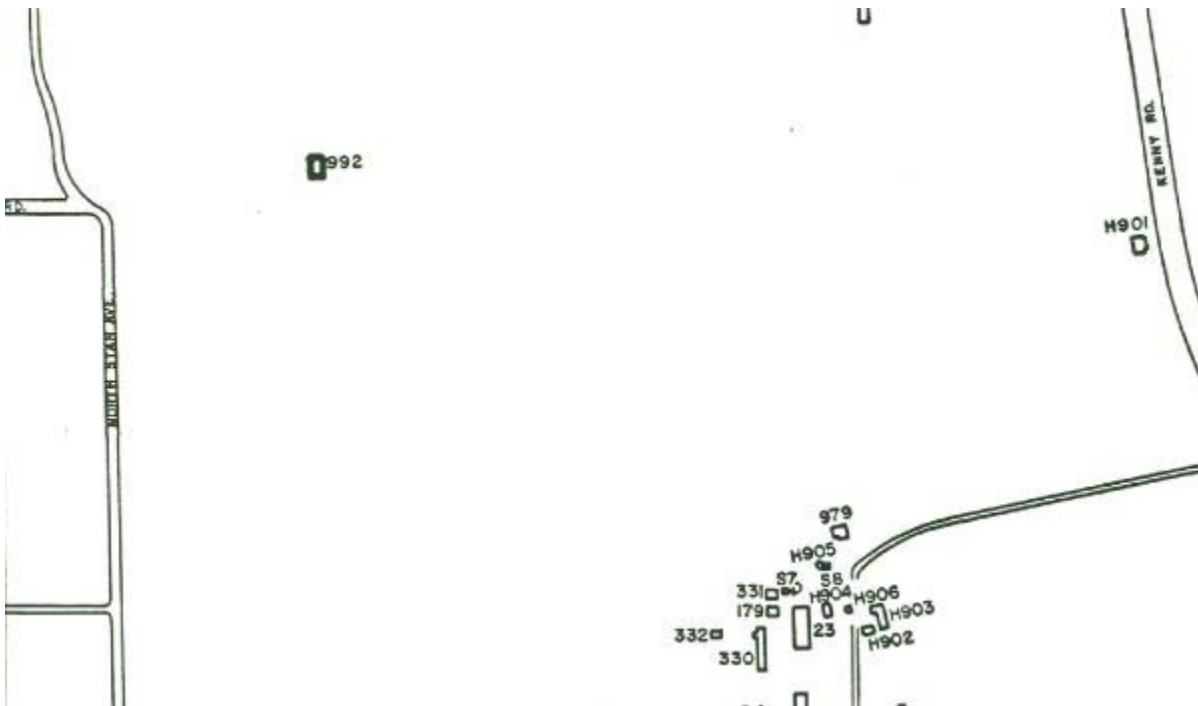

ADDENDUM NO. 1

In October and November, 1973 this building was increased to a bit more than twice its original size. The addition was a pole barn with sheet metal exterior, and was erected by the Umbaugh Pole Barn Company of Delaware. XI2955 and XI2956 are photographs of the enlarged building.
