1. Name

1.1 Never officially named by Board of Trustees action.

1.2 Alternate names noted:

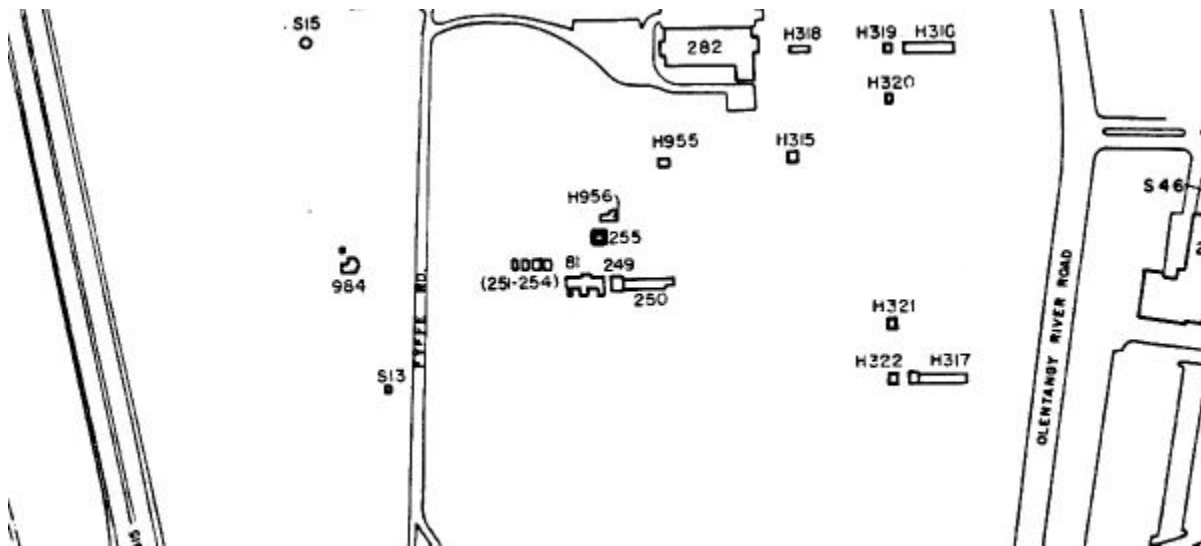
Equipment storage Garage, according to Stadium Superintendent Dolan. Since it serves Trautman Field, it is like to be referred to as the Trautman Field Equipment Storage Garage or the Baseball Storage Garage or some similar name.

A one-story plywood building on wood foundations. Dirt floor. Outside dimensions are approximately 20' x 32'.

B. PLANNING & CONSTRUCTION

1. Building was partially constructed in Stadium by Athletic Department labor and erected by them on the site. Date of erection was probably late 1965. It does not appear in Air View 383 (May, 1965), but does appear in Air View 416 (June, 1966). Anthony Coletta, retired member of the Athletic Department crew,

who helped construct and erect the building, thinks late 1965 is the most probable date.
