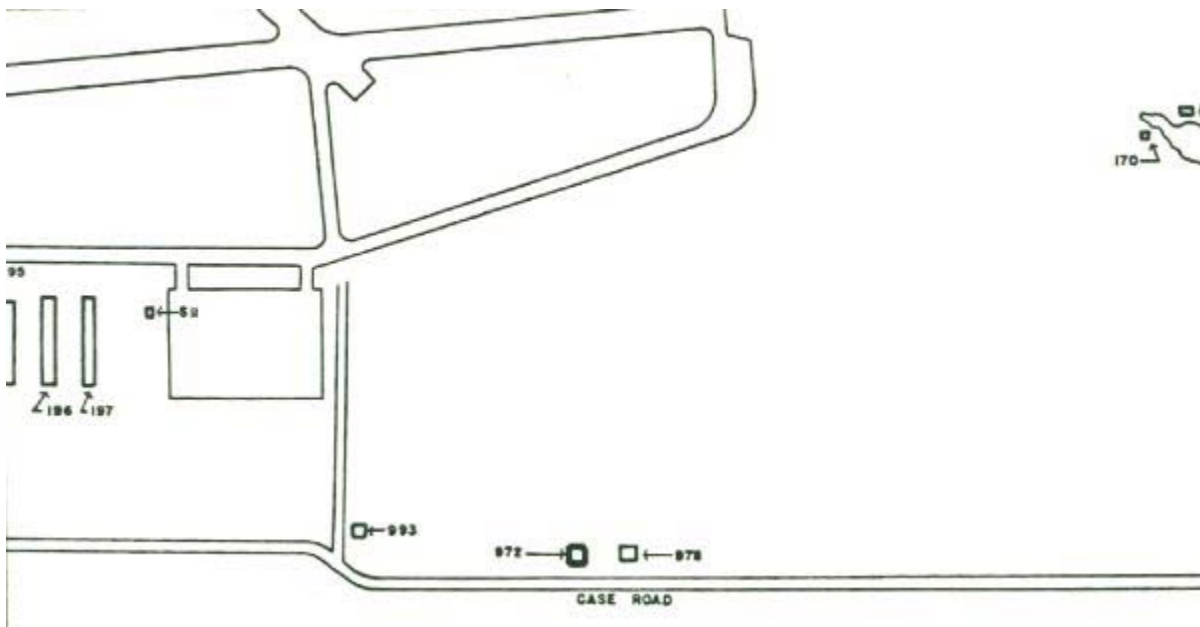

ADDENDUM NO. 2

The sales contract, the application for tax exemption, and the encumbrance estimate in the files of the Office of Property Management indicate that at the time of purchase by the University the property included "farm house, barns, and other buildings."

The nature of the "other buildings" is not known, except that a pumphouse was included.

The Board of Trustees on 11/10/61 authorized the demolition of all buildings at this address except the barn and pumphouse.

ADDENDUM NO. 3

In mid-December, the roof of this barn was damaged by wind. It is the hope of the Farm Operations staff that the building can be demolished and replaced by a new barn east of Building 325. Approval of the erection of a new barn at this location is pending before the Federal Aviation Administration.
