

Gas Meter House

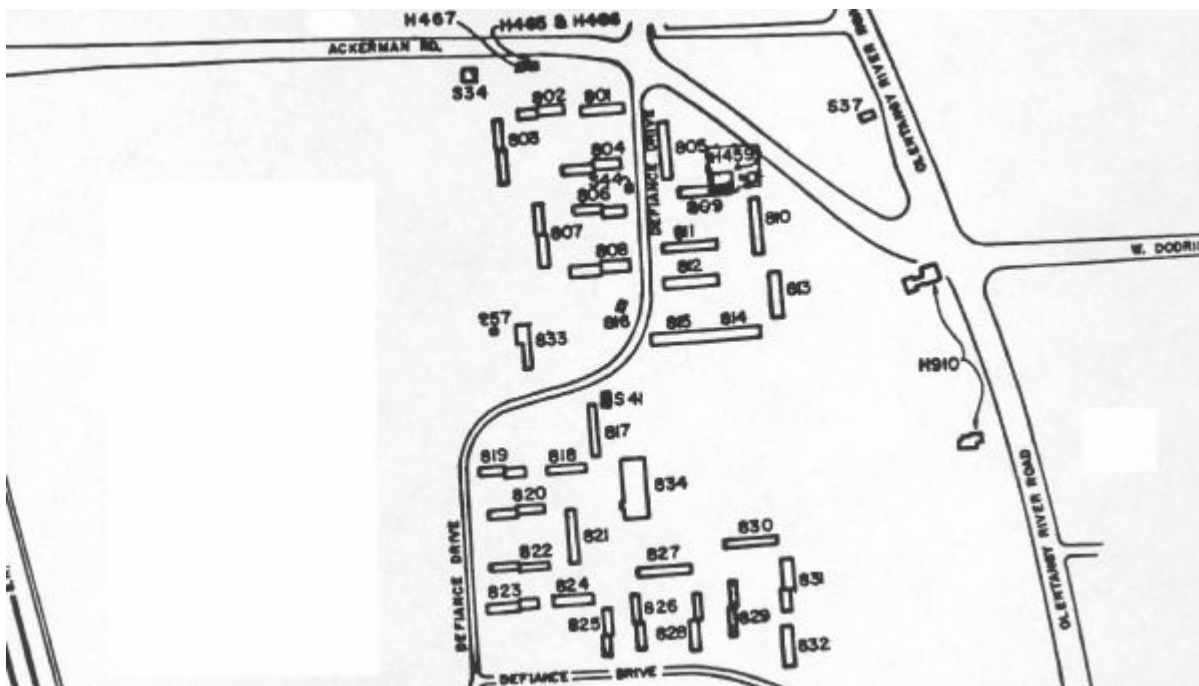
Herrick Archives Building S 34

This is the gas meter house on Ackerman Road serving the married student housing project. The current building, designated S 34, is one of a series of several at or near this location. It was constructed in 1970 because its predecessor had to be razed in connection with the Dodridge-Ackerman Road project.

Prior buildings at or near this location are reported under H 465/7.

Building S 34 is at the northwest corner of Buckeye Village. See map below. See also Sheet 10 in the book of maps in the University Archives.

Building S 34 is a one-story brick structure approximately 35' x 45'.

Construction of this building was started during the week of June 22, 1970, according to records kept by Mr. Theodore Kauer, Expressway Coordinator for the University. It was put into service on September 9, 1970, according to Mr. Steve McCarthy of Columbia Gas of Ohio.
