1.2 Alternate names noted:

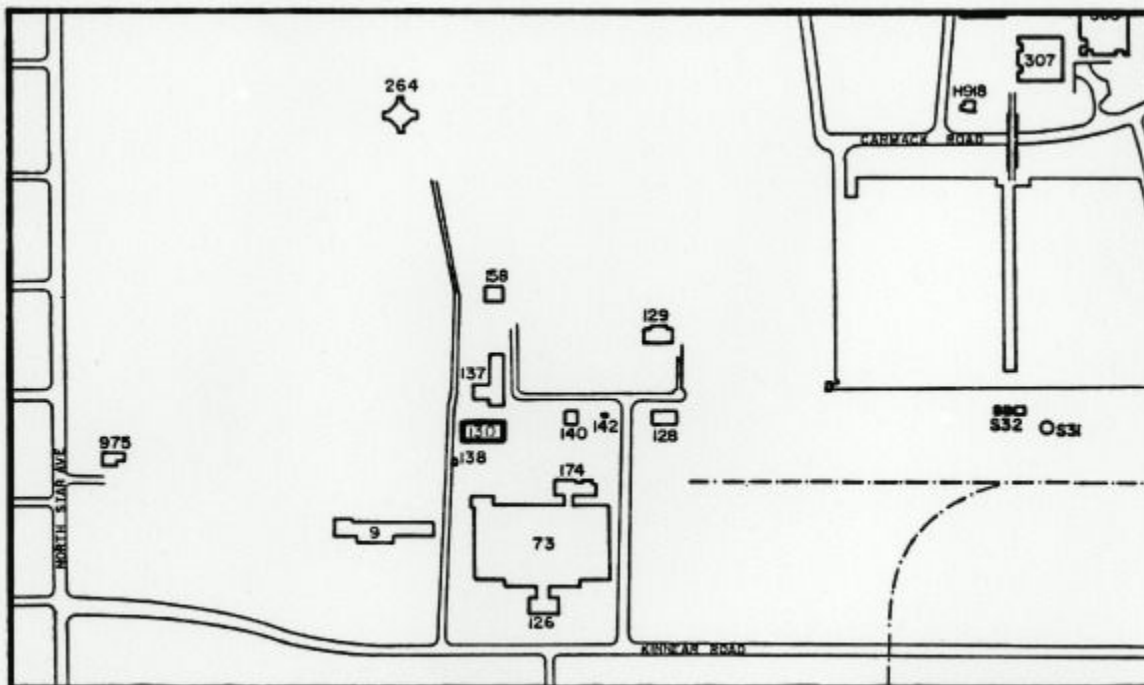
Boiler House.
