A. IDENTIFICATION & LOCATION

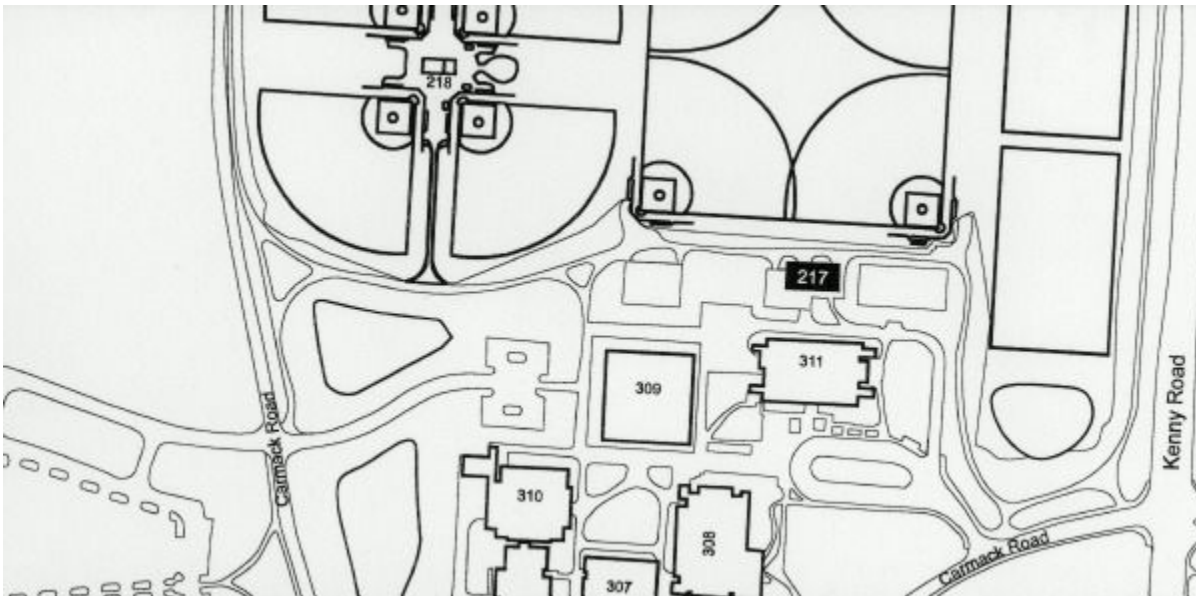
1. Name
