1.1 This and related facilities at this location were officially named "Ohio State University Research Center" by Board of Trustees on April 11, 1955.

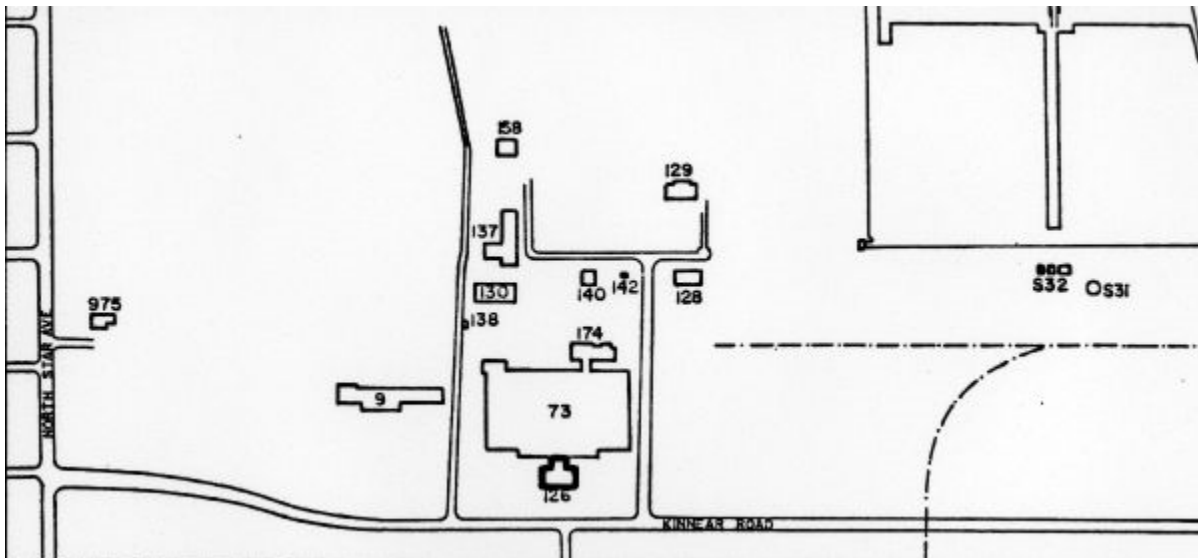
1.2 Alternate names noted:

3.1 Type of construction:

Steel frame with brick exterior.

3.2 No. of stories:

Basement plus two stories.

3.3 Increments of construction:

No additions.

3.4 Present area of building as shown in inventory records of Division of Campus Planning:

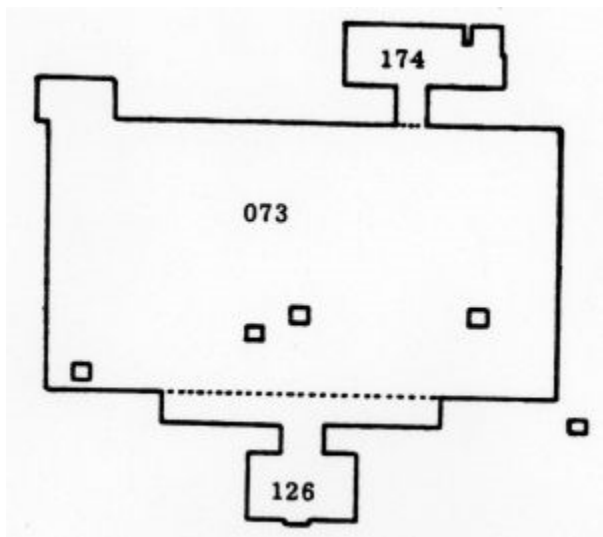
21,604 sq. ft. gross; 12,618 sq. ft. net assignable
