1. Name

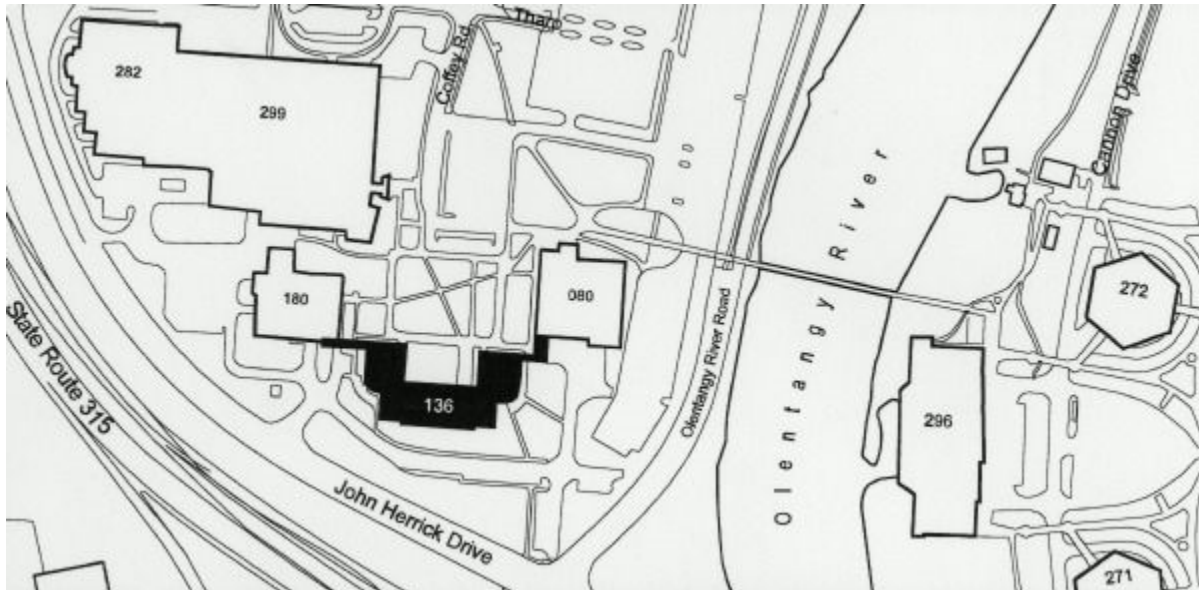
1.1 This building has not been officially named by the Board of Trustees.

Steel frame masonry skin.

3.2 No. of stories:

Five floors plus a basement.

3.3 Gross floor area of 101,538 sq. ft.

3.4 The facility will house research and teaching labs, a library, classrooms, as well as administrative, faculty, and graduate student offices.

3. The design development document was approved on July 16, 1999.
4. Construction document approval was on April 25, 2000.
