A. IDENTIFICATION & LOCATION

1. Name

1.1 Never officially named by Board of Trustees action.

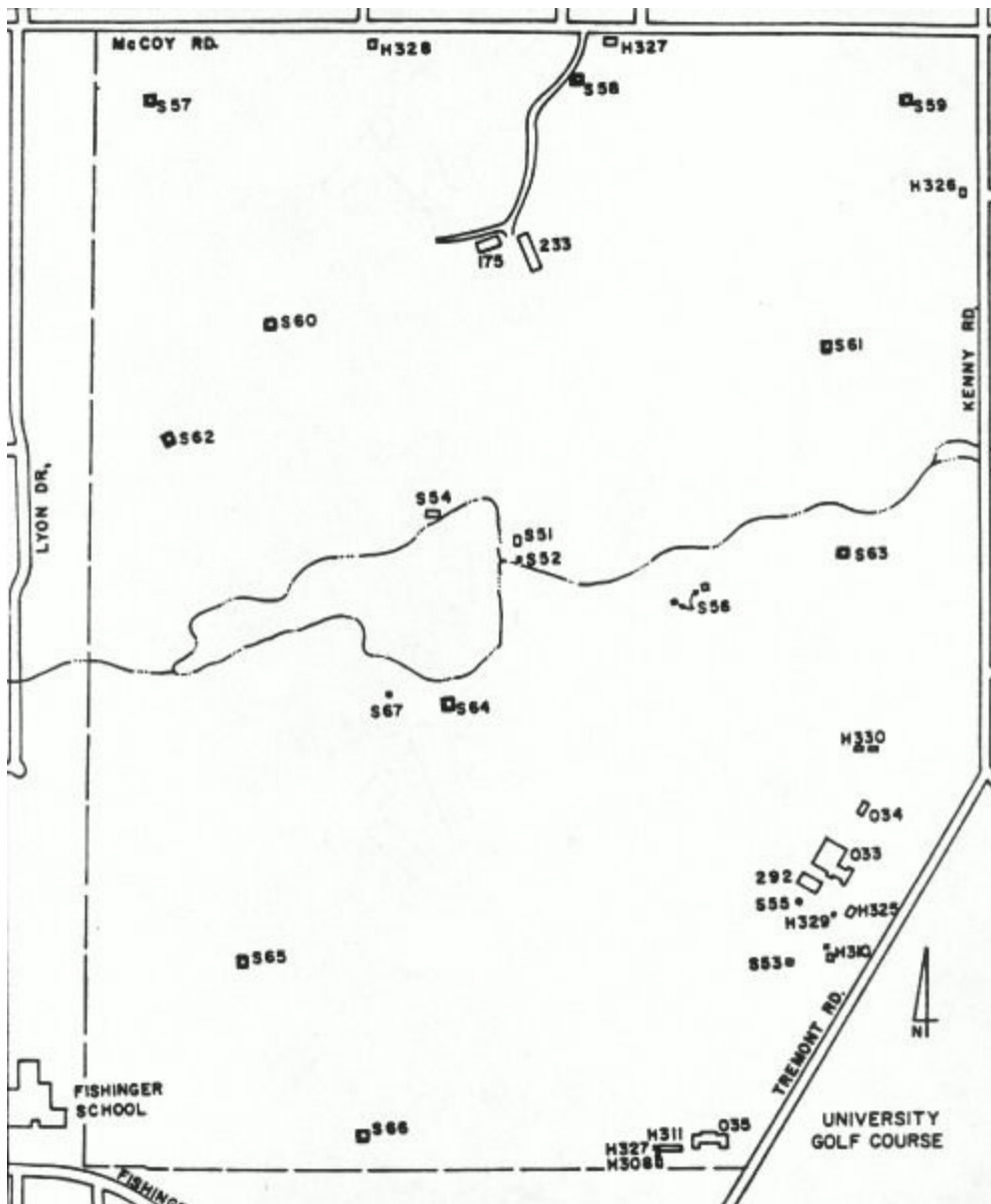

2. Location

3. General Description

3.1 Type of construction:

All simple structures of concrete and stone with wood roof framing and shingles.

3.2 No. of stories:

All one story.

3.3 Increments of construction:

None has been enlarged.

3.4 Size and nature of facilities:

3.4.1 Five of the buildings (S57, 60, 62, 63 and 66) provide shelter only and are approximately 10'6" square. A wide roof overhang brings the dimensions to 16' x 16'.

3.4.2 Five of the buildings are larger (about 10' x 18' including roof overhang) and include tool storage (S58, 59, 61, 64, and 65) and four of these (S58, 60, 64, and 65) include toilets. The toilet in S60 was not in the original building, but was added later. The tool storage space in S58 is now used for vending machines for dispensing beverages.

B. PLANNING & CONSTRUCTION

These structures were designed by Howard Dwight Smith and built by WPA. Golf course records indicate that construction of at least one "tool house and shelter" was under way as early as April 7, 1937 and all 10 were completed by the Summer of 1939. (Ra)
