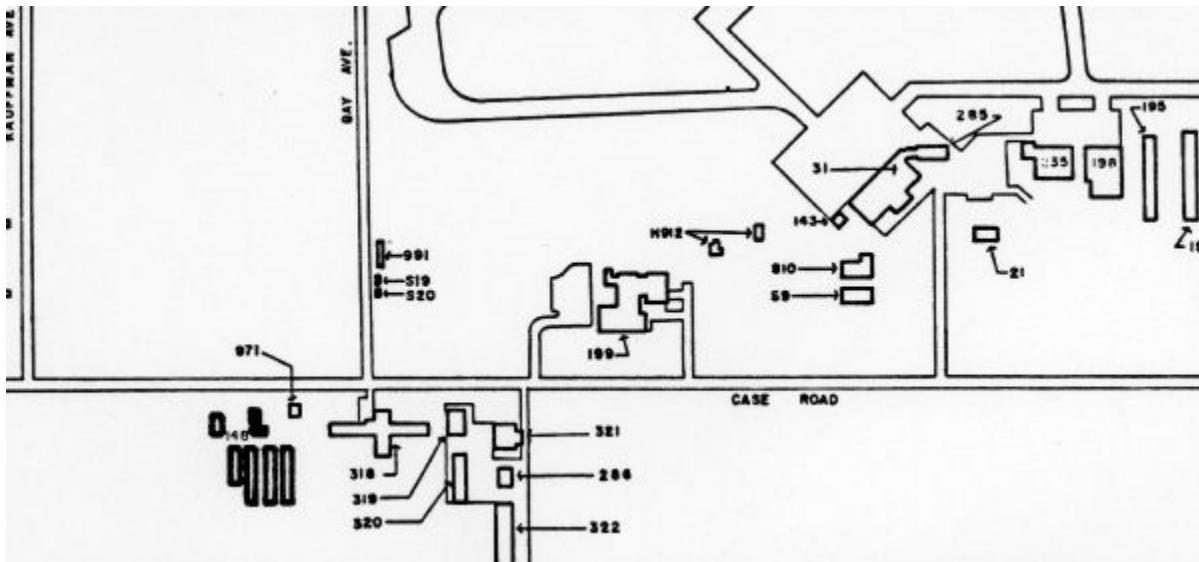

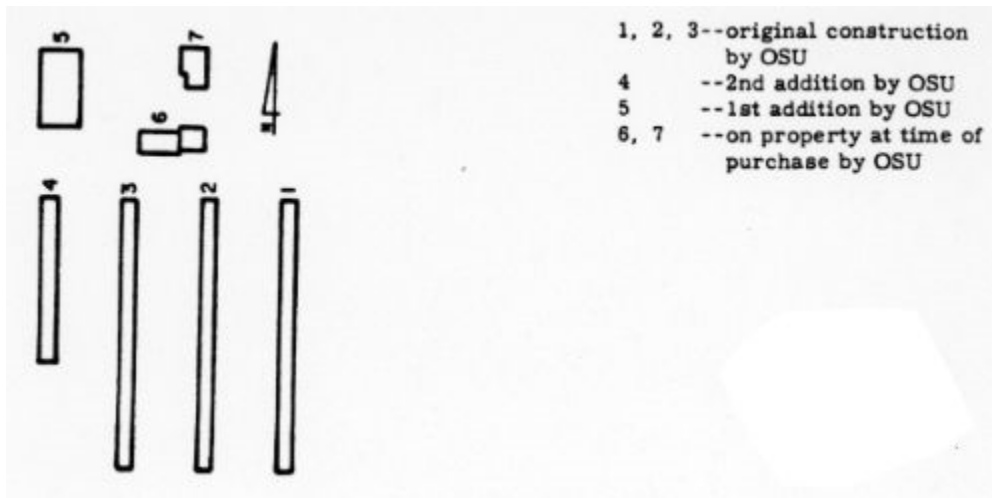

## B. PLANNING & CONSTRUCTION--ORIGINAL CONSTRUCTION BY OSU

1. On April 12, 1954 the Board of Trustees approved the plans and related documents prepared by Howard Dwight Smith and authorized the solicitation of bids by contractors.
2. Bids were received on May 18, 1954 (T).
3. On June 14, 1954 the Board of Trustees awarded contracts to the following contractors:

General: Legg & Davis  
 Electrical: Gustav Hirsch Organization, Inc.  
 Plumbing: Limback Co., Inc.

4. Completion and occupancy:

The work of all contractors was substantially completed by September 30, 1954 (A).

## C. PLANNING AND CONSTRUCTION--BUILDING FOUR (SECOND ADDITION)

1. On October 13, 1958 the Board of Trustees approved the plans and related documents prepared by W. E.

Linch and authorized the solicitation of bids by contractors.

2. Bids were received on November 3, 1958 (T).

3. On November 7, 1958 the Board of Trustees awarded contracts to the following contractors:

General: Kautz Construction Co.

Electrical: Gustav Hirsch Organization, Inc.

Plumbing: Gesling Co.

4. Completion and occupancy:

The work of all contractors was completed between March 3, and April 13, 1958 (A).

#### **D. PLANNING AND CONSTRUCTION--BUILDING FIVE (FIRST ADDITION)**

1. On March 11, 1957 the Board of Trustees approved the plans and related documents prepared by W. E. Linch and authorized the solicitation of bids by contractors.

2. Bids were received on April 15, 1957 (T).

3. On May 13, 1957 the Board of Trustees awarded the general contract and the paving and grading contract to Ralph Kirkham & Sons, Inc.

4. Completion and occupancy:

The contractor's work was completed July 1, 1957 (A).

#### **E. PLANNING AND CONSTRUCTION--BUILDING SIX & SEVEN**

These buildings were on the property at the time of purchase by the University. They are all frame buildings presumably built in conjunction with what is now known as Farm House 18 (Building 971).

The University acquired this property by deed from William F. and Anna M. Lane dated March 19, 1954 (Deed Book 1798, p. 227).

No effort has been made to determine the date of construction of these buildings.

#### **F. COST**

This building is carried at \$94,099.75, which covers Buildings 1-5 only. Approximately \$73,000 of this cost accrued in 1954-55, and presumably represents the cost of Buildings 1-3 (B).
