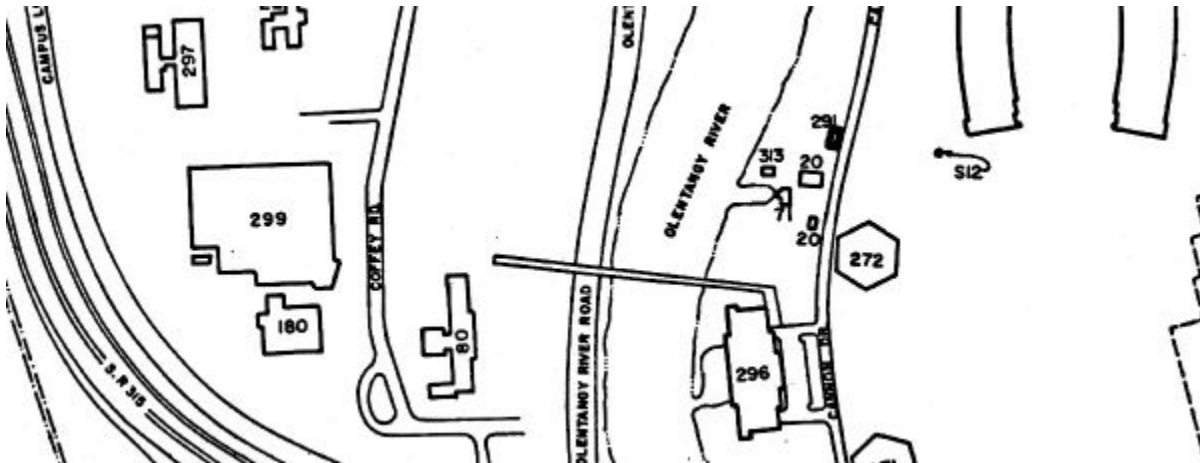

## B. HISTORY OF BUILDING

1. This building was built as a construction office by the contractor for Lincoln and Morrill Towers (Bldgs. 271 and 272). Upon completion of these towers, the building was taken over by the University and used as a temporary bookstore.
2. The building was demolished during the week of October 9, 1972 (PP).
