A. IDENTIFICATION & LOCATION

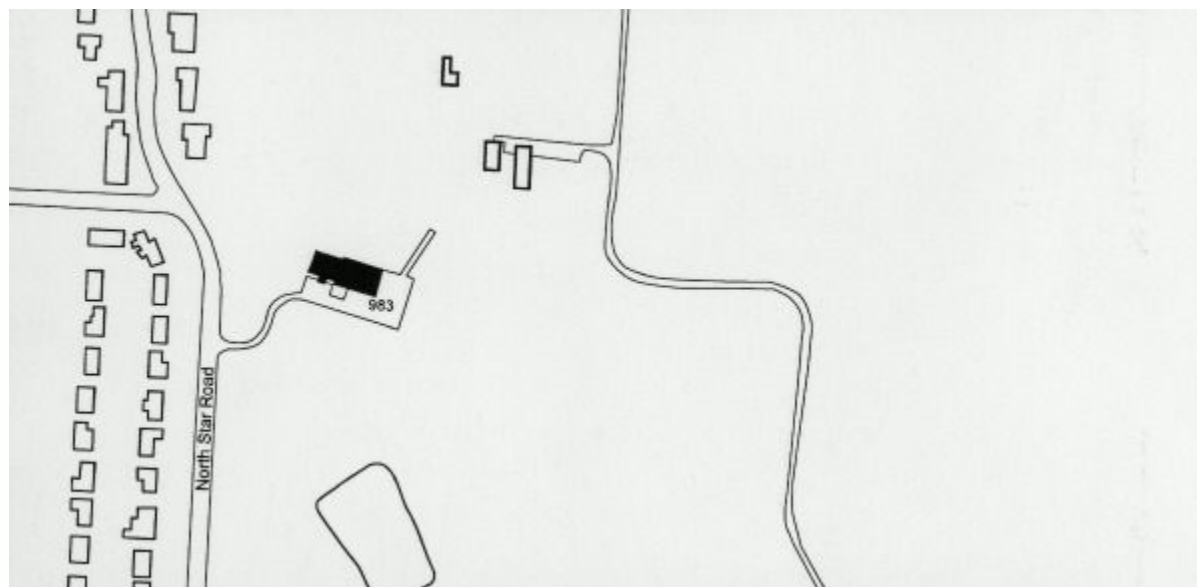
1. Name

6. Construction began on May 8, 1995
7. Report of award to the Board of Trustees on December 1, 1995.
8. The date of completion was July 31, 1996.
