A. IDENTIFICATION & LOCATION

1. Name

1.1 This is a federal building being constructed on campus. The name above appears on the drawings; no name will be assigned by the University.

3. General Description

3.1 The building is of reinforced concrete construction with brick exterior.

3.2 The building is two stories high with no basement.

3.3 Outside dimensions of the building are 154 ft. by 182 ft., according to the drawings.

1. This building is being constructed by the General Services Administration for the Veterans Administration. (A)

4. Construction work began on July 19, 1979 (A).

This building is being built by the University, rather than by any federal agency. It is funded from endowment funds. Upon completion, the building will be leased to the General Services Administration for use by the Veterans Administration.

It is now anticipated that the building will be completed in April, 1981.

The University Architect's office reports that the final inspection prior to acceptance of this building is now scheduled for March 11, 1981.

ADDENDUM NO. 4

This building was ready for release for beneficial occupancy on March 19, 1981, according to University Architect John Seilhamer. However, the building remained unused because of a dispute between the University and the General Services Administration over the amount of rent to be paid. This dispute is reported in the August 14, 1981; September 28, 1981; October 9, 1981 and October 19, 1981 issues of the Lantern.

Agreement was reached late on August 16, 1981, and the Veteran's Administration was free to begin occupancy of the building.

Areas as shown in records of the Office of Campus Planning and Space Utilization are as follows:

56,717 sq. ft. gross; 37,857 sq. ft. net assignable.
