Jason Lyall is currently assistant professor of political science at Yale University. He is also affiliated with the Institution for Social and Policy Studies (ISPS) and the MacMillan Center for International and Area Studies.

His research focuses on the dynamics of violence in both conventional and guerrilla warfare, with special emphasis on Afghanistan and Russia's Northern Caucasus (particularly Chechnya). His works draws on diverse methods, ranging from historical and cross-national comparisons to field and quasi-experiments at the subnational and local level.

His work has been published in the *American Political Science Review*, *International Organization*, *Journal of Conflict Resolution*, and *World Politics*, and has been supported by the United States Institute for Peace and the Macarthur Foundation, among many others.

Lyall received the 2009 Kellogg-Notre Dame Award, the 2007 APSA Helen Dwight Reid Prize for Best Dissertation in International Relations, Law, and Politics, and the 2007 Stanley Kelley Jr. Prize for Teaching Excellence in Princeton University's Politics Department.

He has been a fellow at Harvard University's Olin Institute for Strategic Studies, a visiting scholar at the European University at St. Petersburg, Russia, and he is currently a research fellow at the Counterinsurgency Training Center in Afghanistan (CTC-A).
