
Management of Artificial Lakes and Ponds. *George W. Bennett.* Reinbold Publ. Co. xvii + 283 p. \$8.00.

Dr. George Bennett has produced a book which will meet the needs of fisheries biologists, pond owners, anglers, and wildlife administrators of the northern states; a need which has developed as northerners have been frustrated with their attempts to apply certain concepts and rules which were developed in southern states.

Teachers will find excellent material on the biology of fishes (growth, reproduction, competition, predation, and behavior). The illustrations have been selected wisely, though more would have improved the book. References are cited at the close of each chapter and are more easily consulted there.
