ATTENTION! Stafford Bank Loan Students - Students that are **1st time borrowers** that are receiving loans with a beginning expense period after 1-1-91 are required to attend classes 30 days before they can receive their checks. This policy under the Budget Reconciliation Act of 1990, will require students to purchase books, provide transportation, and personal costs at their own expense for 30 days into the quarter. Please plan ahead if you are receiving a student loan for the 1st time winter quarter.

College Tuition Options Subject Of Forum - Lima Campus will host a public forum on the programs offered by the Ohio Tuition Trust Authority on Mon. Nov. 26 at 7 pm in RH Auditorium. A brief presentation on Ohio's new Guaranteed Tuition Program and College Savings Bond Program will be followed by a question and answer session. The Guaranteed Tuition Program allows for the prepayment of college tuition at any of Ohio's 13 public colleges. The OTTA will also pay the weighted average tuition of Ohio public colleges and universities to any private or out-of-state college. Anyone, regardless of residency, may pre-purchase tuition at today's prices to guarantee that future tuition costs will be covered. Under the College Savings bond program, bonds are sold affordably to individuals and can be used toward college expenses. These bonds are tax-free at both the state and federal levels.
