CZECH ARTIST PRESENTS PROGRAM FOR SERIES - The noted Czechoslovakian artist and theatre set designer Jaroslav Malina will talk about his country and show slides of his work for a Noon Series presentation on Monday March 2 in Reed Hall 160 from 12-12:45. Malina is a personal friend of the country's president, Vaclav Havel, having designed the sets for several of Havel's plays. Also praised as an artist, Malina's work hangs in many prestigious museums and collections throughout Europe.
