Pauline Pope, Program Director for the Western Ohio Regional Training and Habilitation Center will discuss the approaches to prisoner rehabilitation at this new Lima correctional institution. The Center opened in July 1993 for non-violent offenders and uses an all around approach ,i.e., G.E.D. and post high school educational services, abuse counseling, job training, and other social service support counseling in an attempt to return the inmates to society as capable and productive members. Ms. Pope will speak at noon on Tuesday, February 8 in Reed Hall Room 160.

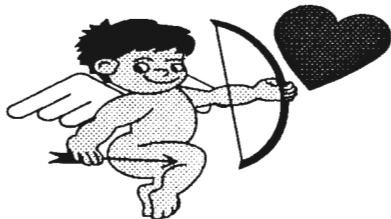

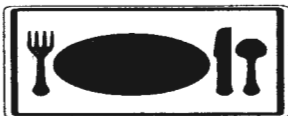

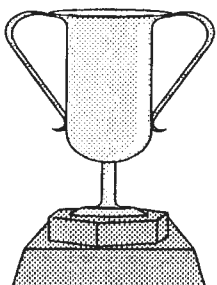
