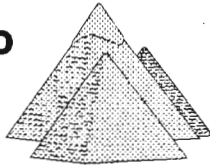

DR. MOHAMED ZEHERY TO PRESENT PROGRAM ON EGYPT



Dr. Mohamed Zehery, Assistant Professor and Head Librarian at the Lima Technical College and the Ohio State University/Lima, will present a lecture-slide program about his native land, EGYPT. He will speak at noon on Thursday, November 3, in Reed Hall 160. Dr. Zehery received his undergraduate degree in Library Science from Cairo University, Cairo, Egypt. He emigrated to the United States, where he continued his education, receiving his master's degree from Western Michigan University and a doctorate degree in Library and Information Science from the University of North Texas. He has been active in international librarianship where he developed and provided consulting services to international and regional organizations, such as UNESCO, WHO, and ILO.

STUDENT LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE TO BE HELD SATURDAY

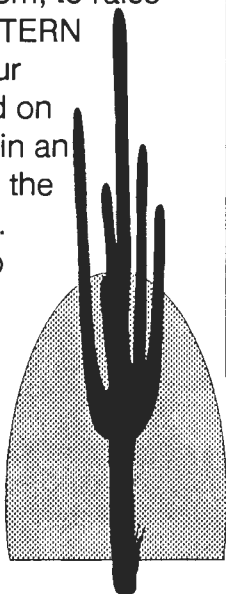
