Free tutoring is available in the Psych Lab (GA 430) for Psych 100. Tutors are available at the following times:

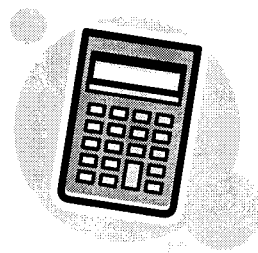

Applications can be picked up in the Financial Aid Office.

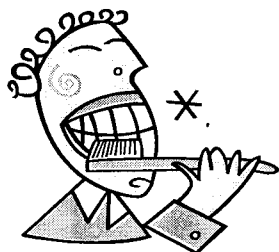
Dental Clinic

Schedule an appointment to get your teeth cleaned at the Rhodes State College Dental Hygiene Clinic.

The clinic welcomes all students, faculty, and staff of the Lima Campus to make an appointment by calling 419-995-8346 or by stopping by the clinic in Cook Hall (next to the library). Community patients are also welcome.

Services provided include teeth cleaning, oral health instructions, oral cancer screening, diabetic screening, bitewing x-rays, fluoride treatment, tooth desensitization, and nutritional counseling.

Cleanings are FREE for students, faculty and staff; however, a nominal fee is charged for panoramic and cmx x-rays. Dental hygiene students are supervised by licensed dental professionals.

Homecoming Game: Tailgate, Skull session & the game (either at the stadium for students with tickets or Alumni House on Big Screen TV's)

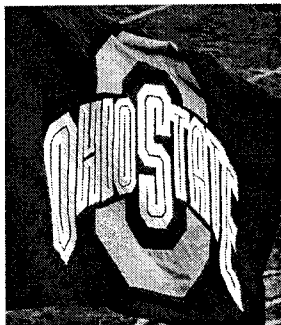
Who: All current OSU students, with preference given to first year students at Ohio State-Lima

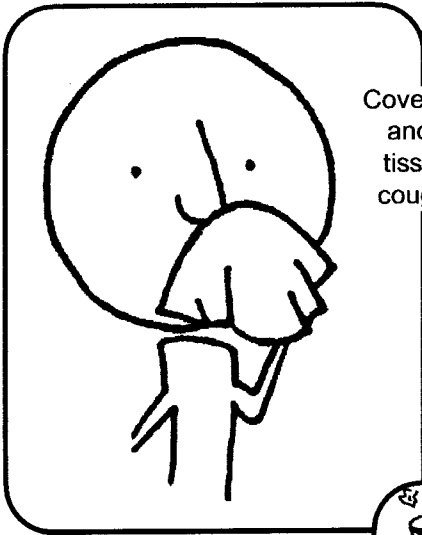

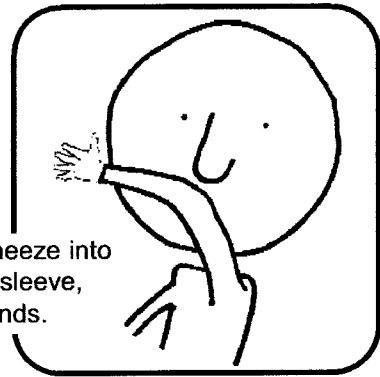

Cover your Cough

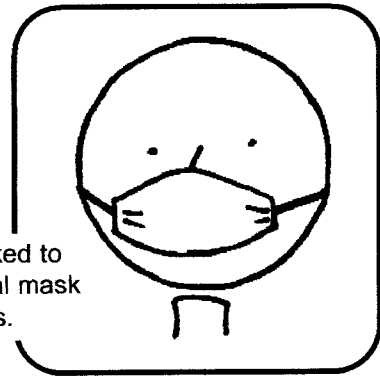


Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze

or cough or sneeze into your upper sleeve, not your hands.



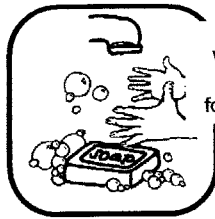
Put your used tissue in the waste basket.



You may be asked to put on a surgical mask to protect others.

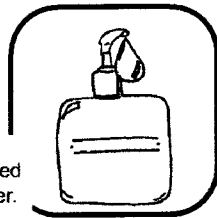
Clean your Hands

or clean with alcohol-based hand cleaner.

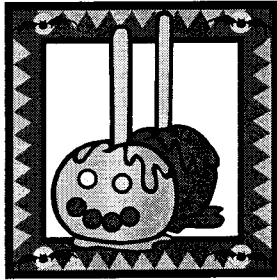
