## Student Trustee Position

Each year, one Ohio State Lima student is selected to represent the student body on the Ohio State Lima Board of Trustees. This is your invitation to apply to be that student! The Board is made up of successful and well-connected community members from our surrounding counties who help lead the strategic planning and mission of our campus. The student representative is called upon to be the student voice of the Board.

Consider this WONDERFUL opportunity to become engaged in planning Ohio State Lima's future (and to make some great contacts for your future)!

Applications for the position of student trustee are available in the office of the Dean and Director (PS 208). Completed applications are to be returned to the Dean and Director's office no later than **April 16, 2007**. The student trustee serves a one year term, beginning in July. Eligible candidates must meet the following **qualifications:**

- Must have a minimum of a 2.5 GPA
- Must have completed 24 credit hours on the Ohio State Lima campus, be currently enrolled, and plan to be a full-time student during 2007-08
- Must have had interaction with campus organizations/student activities
- Must be available to attend and participate in a monthly meeting of the Ohio State Lima Board of Trustees, which typically meets on the second Thursday of each month at 4 pm.

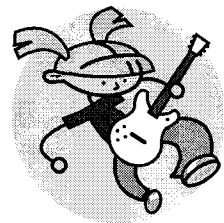

The movie "Night at the Museum" (rated PG) on Friday, April 20th at 7:00pm. The movie will be playing in SCI room 100.

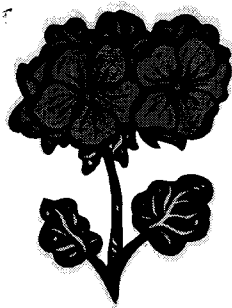
