Maxwell House (R) Talent Show - Any student who is an individual performer (singer, dancer, musician, juggler, etc) may audition for the Maxwell House (R) Talent Show. The program will take place in Columbus (main campus) on February 10, 1984. Prizes include up to \$1500 in scholarship money. Since only 10 acts may participate in the actual program, auditions will be held on January 10 and 11. All performers from OSU at Lima will be scheduled to audition on the same day, to facilitate car pooling. Performers must provide their own accompanist.

Ski Club - The Ski Club went on a successful trip to Boyne Mountain over break and they are off again this weekend. Deadline for registration for the February trip is January 4th (TODAY), don't miss it. The next trip will be held Feb 3-5 to Saberfae.
