Is Your Home Safe From Dangerous Radon? - The students and faculty of the Lima Tech Respiratory Care Program are offering Radon test kits. The kits are approved by the American Lung Association of Western Ohio and determine the levels of radon gas present in your home. In a recent study, preliminary results showed the Lima area to have a higher than expected level. Test kits are available from Respiratory Care students, or contact the faculty in Cook Hall. Cost for the kit is \$11.00 and includes interpretation.
