is one of the editors of *Litterae Textuales*, a series of some renown among scholars of Western manuscripts. It encompasses everything По-лата кѣнѣгопнѣснага would wish to represent in Slavic studies: Palaeography and codicology, as well as classical and medieval litera-

ture, in so far as its study is based directly on manuscripts. Owing to his initiative, and under his own editorial responsibility, seven volumes of *Litterae Textuales* have been devoted to a survey of the present state and scope of manuscript studies under the general subtitle *Codicologica*. Even though Codicologica is not primarily written for scholars of Slavic manuscripts, and even though it is not designed to give exhaustive coverage of all questions in the field, the bearing of most of the contributions is so general that it seems an ideal compendium to give Slavists direct access to the results of the main discussions among Western codicologists, which will not fail to prove most stimulating for Slavic codicology.
