FENCING

The Ohio State fencing team finished in fifth at the 2015 NCAA Championships, marking the 14th-consecutive Top-10 finishes for the Buckeyes at the event. Sophomore Alanna Goldie, women's foil, added another bronze medal to her repertoire, while freshman Lewis Weiss earned his first bronze in men's epee. The pair claimed All-America honors, freshman Marc-Antoine Blais Belanger claimed a spot on Second Team. In all, 24 members of the Scarlet and Gray squad earned OSU Scholar Athlete accolades.

FENCING

The Ohio State fencing team finished fourth at the 2014 NCAA Championships in Columbus. Eight of the 12 Buckeyes that competed earned All-America status. Alanna Goldie received First Team All-American accolades with her third place finish in women's foil. Mona Shaito, fifth in women's foil, Alexa Antipas, sixth in women's sabre, Zain Shaito, sixth in men's foil, and Kristian Boyadzhiev, fifth in men's epee, all received Second Team All-American honors. Fares Arfa, ninth in men's sabre, Celina Merza, ninth in women's sabre, and Caroline Piasecka, 11th in women's epee, were All-American honorable mentions.
