Submission of a manuscript is understood to mean that the work is original and unpublished, and is not being considered for publication elsewhere. All manuscripts considered for publication will be peer-reviewed. The opinions expressed by reviewers are their own, and do not represent the views of the Ohio Academy of Science or THE OHIO JOURNAL OF SCIENCE. Manuscripts and illustrations should be prepared in triplicate in accordance with current guidelines published in THE JOURNAL at least once a year, and submitted to:

Page Charges:

Publication of *THE OHIO JOURNAL OF SCIENCE* requires that authors assist in meeting publication expenses. These costs will be assessed at \$75 per page for members of the Academy and \$110 per page for non-members. In multi-authored papers, **each author must be a member of the Academy** at the time of publication to be eligible for the reduced member rate. Papers which exceed 12 printed pages may be charged full production costs. A bill for page charges will be sent to the communicating author by the Ohio Academy of Science at the time of publication.
