West Campus--Fifth Building

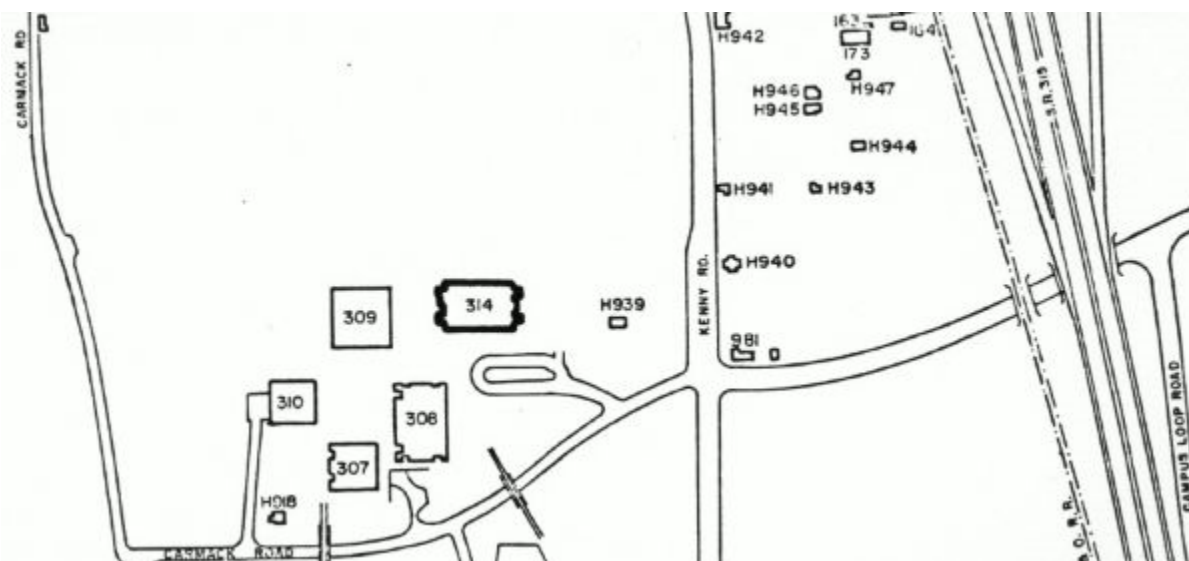

3. General Description

3.1 Type of construction:

Reinforced concrete frame with brick exterior.

3.2 No. of stories:

Basement and two stories.

3.3 Increments of construction:

No additions.

3.4 Present area of building as shown tentatively in inventory records of Division of Campus Planning:

74,533 square feet gross; 49,708 square feet net assignable.

3.5 The five small buildings south of the main building are bus stop shelters (see Sheet 64 referred to in 2.2 above).

B. PLANNING & CONSTRUCTION

1. On May 5, 1972 the Board of Trustees approved the plans and related documents prepared by Holroyd and Myers and authorized the solicitation of bids by contractors.

2. Bids were received on June 22, 1972 (T).

3. On July 7, 1972 the Board of Trustees awarded contracts to the following contractors:

General: Knowlton Construction Co.

Electrical: Burroughs-Hatfield Electric Co.

Heating, ventilating, & air conditioning: J. A. Guy, Inc.

Plumbing: J. A. Carson Plumbing & Heating, Inc.

4. Completion and occupancy:

Expected to be ready for use in September 1974 (P).
