MANUSCRIPTS. THE OHIO JOURNAL OF SCIENCE accepts manuscripts on any scientific subject from contributors living anywhere in the world. The manuscripts may be reports of recent research, review or expository articles, or part of a symposium on a subject of general scientific interest. All manuscripts are subject to approval by the editorial staff. One original copy only need be submitted to the Editor. A carbon copy should be retained by the author in case of loss of the original and for reading the galley proof. Galley proof and engraver's proof but not original manuscript will be sent to authors. Care should be taken to furnish a correct mailing address. See cover page 3 for detailed instructions concerning the preparation of manuscripts.

PREPUBLICATION REVIEW AND REVISION. Every paper is read and criticized by a reviewer. The author is subsequently given an opportunity to revise the paper in accordance with the reviewer's suggestions. This procedure is not intended to imply any reflection on the merits of individual papers but is solely for the purpose of improving the quality of articles appearing in the Journal and to reduce publication costs.

REPRINTS. A price list for reprints and an order form are sent with proof.

SUBSCRIPTIONS. Annual subscription, \$4.00, (foreign countries, \$4.50). Single numbers, \$1.00. One volume appears each year and contains six numbers. THE OHIO JOURNAL OF SCIENCE is sent without additional expense to all paid-up members of the OHIO ACADEMY OF SCIENCE.
