THE JOURNAL CHANGES EDITORS AND MANAGERS

At a recent meeting of the Joint Administrative Board of the Ohio Journal of Science the resignation of the editor, Dr. Laurence H. Snyder, was accepted with regret. Dr. Snyder became Associate Editor of the Journal in 1932, and Editor-in-Chief in 1933. During his ten years with the Journal several customs have been inaugurated, among which are the reviewing of books, the coöperative publishing of symposia of the Society of the Sigma XI, and periodic exhibits before the Academy of Science of the detailed manner of printing and publishing the Journal.

The new Editor-in-Chief is Dr. Glenn W. Blaydes of the Department of Botany of the Ohio State University. Dr. Blaydes has been the Associate Editor for the past year, and is well acquainted with the problems and interests of the Journal.

Last spring Dr. Bernard S. Meyer resigned after ten years as Business Manager of the Journal, and his place was filled by Dr. John A. Miller of the Department of Zoölogy of the Ohio State University. The Ohio Academy of Science and the Ohio State University wish success to the new Editor and Business Manager at the start of their careers.
