Biologic Science in Laboratory and Field. *William C. Beaver.* The C. V. Mosby Co., St. Louis. Fourth edition, 1952. 253 pp., paper bound. \$3.50.

These volumes are designed as a text book and laboratory-field manual, respectively, for a year's course in biology. The use of the scientific method as a means of observing and recording facts, formulating conclusions, and deriving principles from them is stressed. The author feels that illustrations need not be included for the entertainment of the student, but rather to assist him in gathering and evaluating facts scientifically. Nevertheless there are 375 illustrations in the text and several in the manual, including some outline drawings to be completed by the student.
