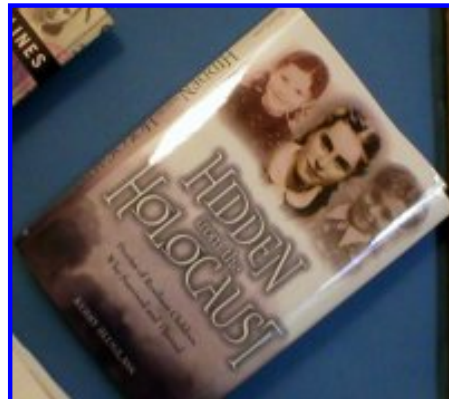

Wonders and Miracles: Art of the Passover Haggadah



The Melton Center for Jewish Studies and The Jewish Studies Library at The Ohio State University Libraries in collaboration with the Columbus Museum of Art and the Klau Library of Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion, Cincinnati

March 18 - May 2, 2004

During each spring, Jews all over the world celebrate Passover to commemorate the liberation of the Jewish people from bondage in Egypt in biblical times. At the Seder, a festive ritual meal, the retelling of the



Passover story is read from a special book called a haggadah. *Wonders and Miracles: Art of the Passover Haggadah* features a sampling of original haggadot (plural of haggadah) that date from the Renaissance to the present. The beautifully illustrated books reflect the creativity of the artists and the artistic styles that flourished at a particular time and place. In addition to exemplifying the Jewish tradition of creating ritual objects of beauty, the illustrated haggadot also have the practical benefit of helping maintain the attention of Seder participants, especially children. Printed haggadot from Prague (1526), Mantua (1560), Venice (1609), and Amsterdam (1695) became the models for Passover prayer books well into the twentieth century. The tradition of unique manuscript haggadot began in the Middle Ages and continues in contemporary examples from Italy and Israel featured in the exhibition. Twentieth-century printed editions include the work of well-known artists such as Leonard Baskin and Ben Shahn. The haggadot in *Wonders and Miracles* are from the collection of Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion's Klau Library in Cincinnati with additional books from the Jewish Studies Library at The Ohio State University and private collections.

On Thursday, April 1, the public is invited to a lecture entitled "Art and Whimsy of the Passover Haggadah" by David J. Gilner, Director of Libraries at Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion, Cincinnati. A reception follows the lecture. Both the lecture and reception are free of charge. A color brochure about the exhibition and a special activity sheet for families and school groups will be available.

This exhibition at the Columbus Museum of Art is supported by the Melton Center for Jewish Studies at The Ohio State University with additional support from the Jewish Arts Endowment of the Columbus Jewish Foundation.

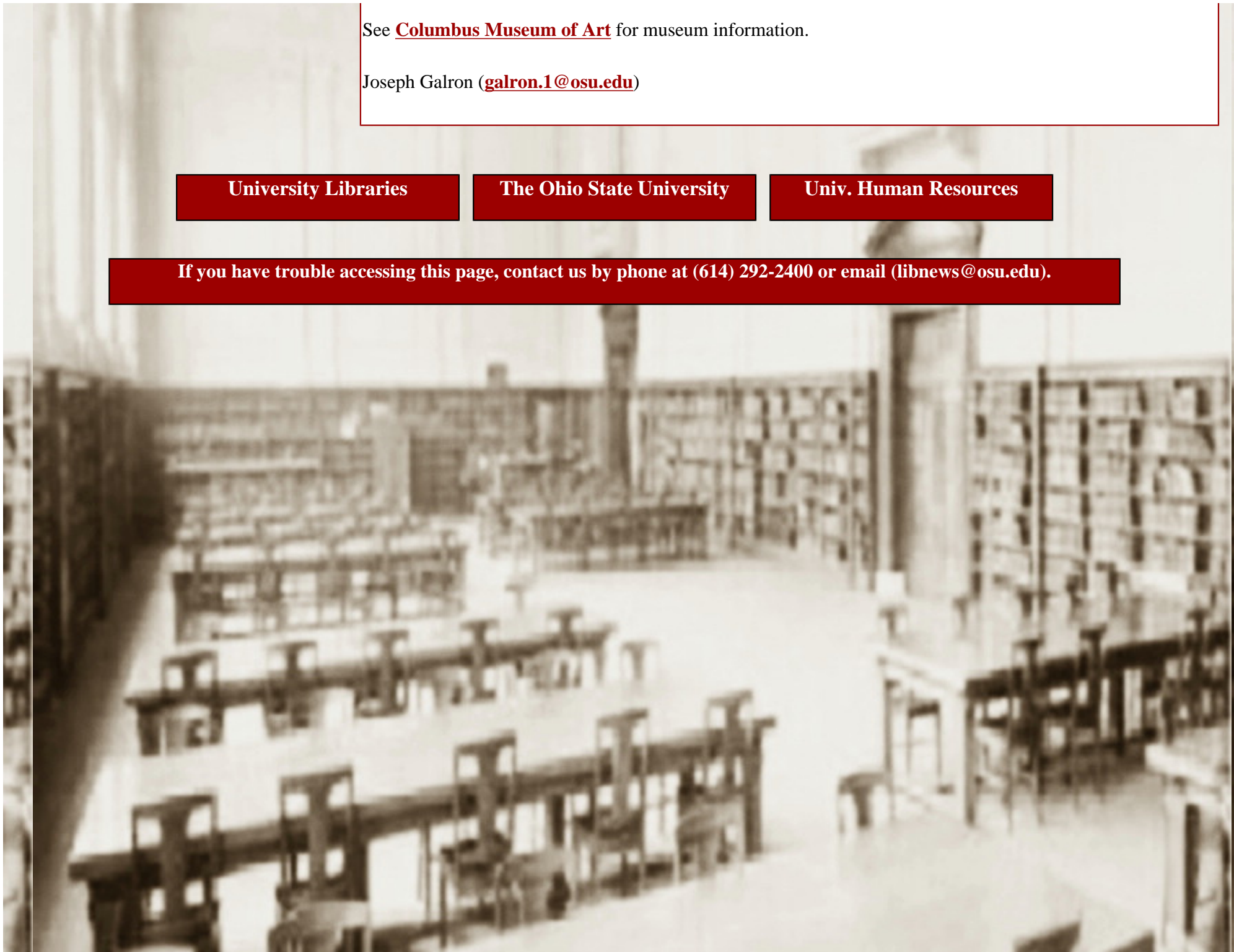

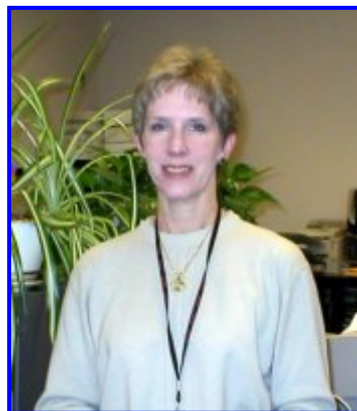
Campus Campaign "Win a Prize" Drawing Winner
