
Physiological Chemistry

The sixth edition of this text is a revised, enlarged and up to date version of biochemistry. It is presented from a broad biological viewpoint and in a manner which arouses the student's interest by challenging his scientific imagination.

The book is ideally suited to the needs of medical students in its selection, arrangement and emphasis of material. Its greatest asset, however, is that it leaves the medical student with an integrated picture of the various phases of body chemistry and thereby provides him with a basis for understanding later courses in normal and pathological physiology and the rationale of therapy.
