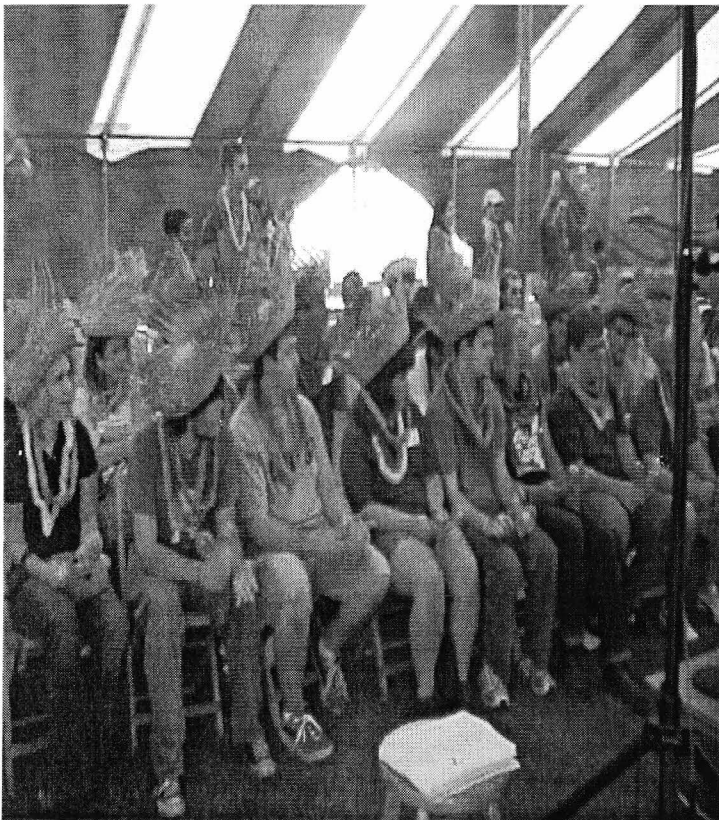

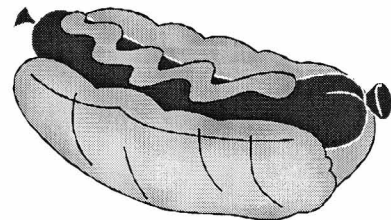

The Math club's first meeting is Tuesday, September 30th, at noon.

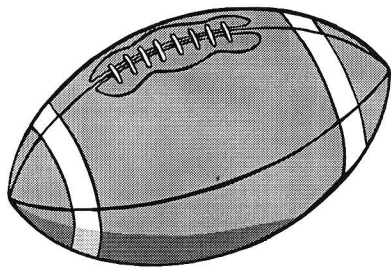
The meeting will be held in GA 315. All students with an interest in math are welcome to attend.

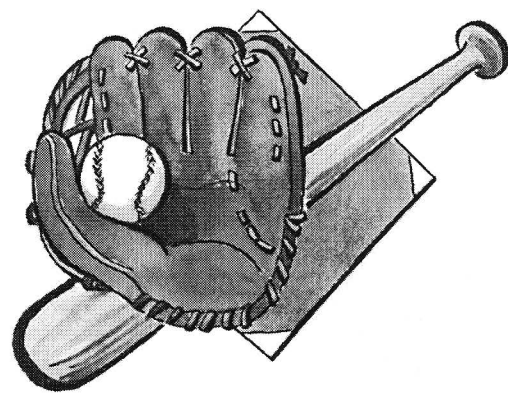

Parking on campus

Vehicle registration is required to park in the campus parking lots. Vehicle decals may be obtained from the Safety and Security Department office (Tech Lab 140B)

Lima Campus regulations

1. Student parking is prohibited in Visitor Parking spaces.
2. Unauthorized parking in handicap parking spaces is a violation and may result in a parking citation and fine issued by the Allen County Sheriff's Department.
3. Parking in areas designated as fire lanes is strictly prohibited
5. Parking violations may result in a fine and/or the vehicle being towed and impounded with the owner having to pay all costs.
6. Gated parking lots are reserved for registered faculty and staff.
7. Please note the posted speed limit, which is in effect all around campus and is enforced at all times.

If a parking citation is received, the fine may be paid at the Safety and Security Department, TL 140B, between 8am-5pm within 5 business days.

Dental Clinic

The Rhodes State College Dental Hygiene Clinic welcomes all students, faculty and staff of the Lima Campus to make an appointment by calling (419) 995-8346 or stopping over to the clinic in Cook Hall (next to the library). Services provided include teeth cleaning, x-rays, fluoride treatment, dental sealants, and oral health instructions. Cleanings are free for students, faculty and staff, however, a nominal fee is charged for x-rays. Dental hygiene students are supervised by licensed dental professionals.

ATTENTION RHODES STATE GRADUATE-HOPEFULS!

In order to have your degree and diploma awarded, you must petition to graduate. Petition forms can be found in the Financial Aid Department, PS 150, and must be turned in to the Business Office in PS 222, along with the \$12 petitioning fee. Plan ahead! Deadlines for petitioning may be earlier than you expect!

Deadlines for Petition to Graduate:

Fall Quarter 2003-----July 15, 2003

Winter Quarter 2004-----October 15, 2003

Spring Quarter 2004-----January 15, 2004

If you have petitioned previously, but did not graduate that quarter, you must re-petition in order to attain your degree.

Franklin on Campus

Franklin University Regional Director Joyce Upham will be at James A. Rhodes State college on Tuesday, September 30th to discuss the Community College Alliance (CAA) program with Rhodes State students. She will be in the Tech Lab lobby, from 10 am to 1 pm and from 4 to 6 pm

The CCA is a Bachelor's degree completion program that allows students in the US to combine on-campus course work at their local community college with online classes through Franklin to completion their degree.

After completing their associates degree at James A. Rhodes students take bridge courses (approximately 36 semester/24 quarter unities) at James A. Rhodes and online classes (minimum 40 semester credit hours) through Franklin University to earn one of 10 bachelor of science degrees.
