## Weather Delay Information

If weather forces a delay, classes will usually begin at 10:00 a.m. The portion of the class that was scheduled prior to the announced delay time will be cancelled as well as that portion of the same class that extends no more than 30 minutes beyond the delayed start time. For example, if campus delays until 10:00 a.m., a class starting at 8 a.m. and ending at 10:20 a.m. will be canceled for the day. However, a class starting at 8 a.m. but ending at 11:00 a.m. would still be holding class for one hour starting at 10:00 a.m. Activities scheduled to begin on or after the delayed start time will be conducted in a normal manner with students held responsible for all material presented.
