

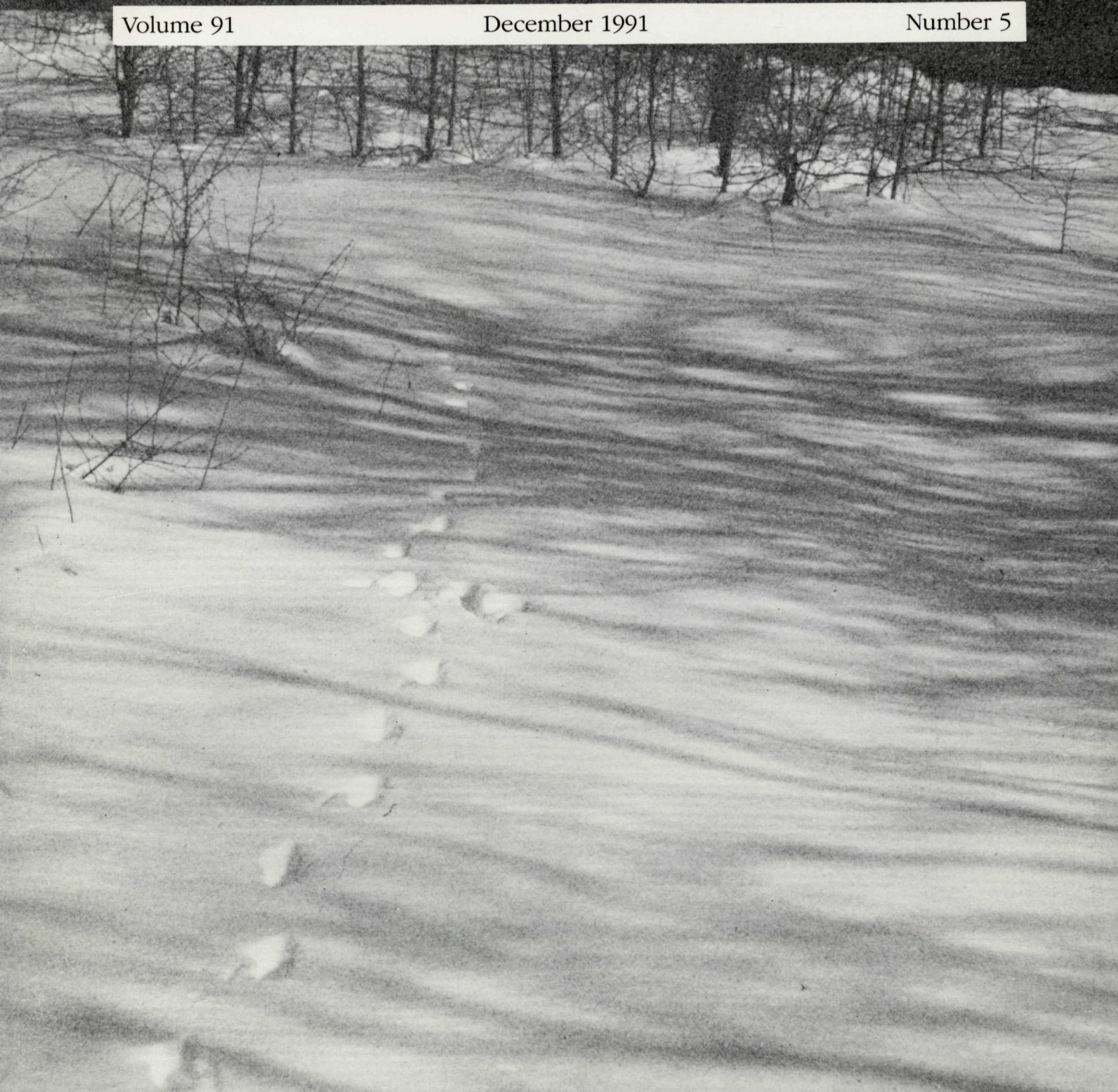

**General:**

While special consideration will be given to manuscripts concerned with Ohio subject matter, other reports with scientific merit will be reviewed for publication. Submission of a manuscript is understood to mean that the work is original and unpublished, and is not being considered for publication elsewhere. All manuscripts considered for publication will be peer-reviewed. The opinions expressed by reviewers are their own, and do not represent the views of the Ohio Academy of Science or *THE OHIO JOURNAL OF SCIENCE*. Manuscripts and illustrations should be prepared in **triplicate** in accordance with current guidelines published in *THE JOURNAL* at least once a year, and submitted to:

**Page Charges:**

Publication of *THE OHIO JOURNAL OF SCIENCE* requires that authors assist in meeting publication expenses. These costs will be assessed at \$70 per page for members of the Academy and \$105 per page for non-members. Papers which exceed 12 printed pages may be charged full production costs. A bill for page charges will be sent to the communicating author by the Ohio Academy of Science at the time of publication.
