Applications are available in the hallway by the Bookstore (PS 114). **Deadline: March 11, 2005**

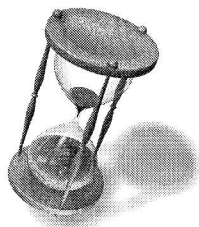

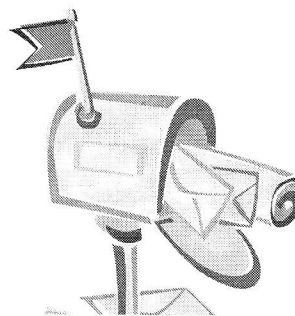

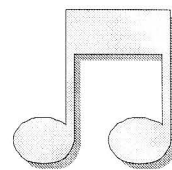
MUSIC 221
