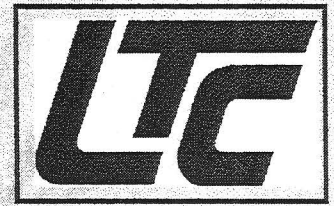




## Your Weekly Student Newsletter

#### Choral Concert

The annual University Chorus Spring Concert will be held on Friday, June 4th, at 8:00pm in the Reed Auditorium.

The choir will be presenting a program offering a wide range of choral repertoire from historical sacred and secular works including: "Festival Te Deum", by Linda Spevacek-Avery; "Laudamus Te" and "Domini Fili," from *Gloria* by Francis Poulenc; "My Heart's in the Highlands," by Donald Moore; "Hush! Somebody's Callin' My Name," Traditional Spiritual; two Vocal Jazz arrangements of "Lonesome Road" and "52nd Street," by Kirby Shaw; to "Wheels of a Dream" from *Ragtime*, a 1998 Tony nominated musical, arr. by John Leaveitt; and several additional light selections to round out the program.

The choir is directed by Dr. Richard L. Mallonee, Director of Choral Programs, with Mr. Dean Altstaetter, accompanist. Debbie Hays (Kenton) will be featured soloist in the spiritual, Lisa Bacome (Bath), Glenn Kahler, and Dean Altstaetter will be featured soloists in "52nd Street." Miss Bacome will additionally serve as String Bassist on both Shaw selections. The concert is free, and the public is cordially invited to attend. 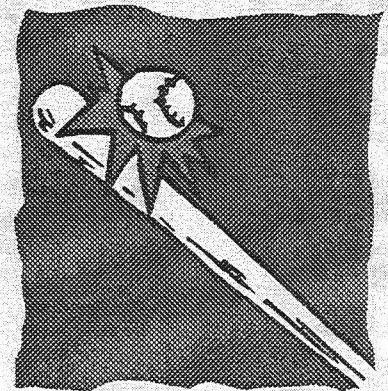

### *Hugh Engstrom Memorial Scholarship*

## Attention OSU Students:

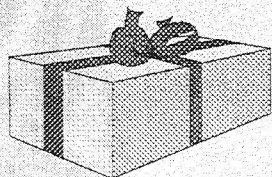
