1.1 Building was never officially named by Board of Trustees.

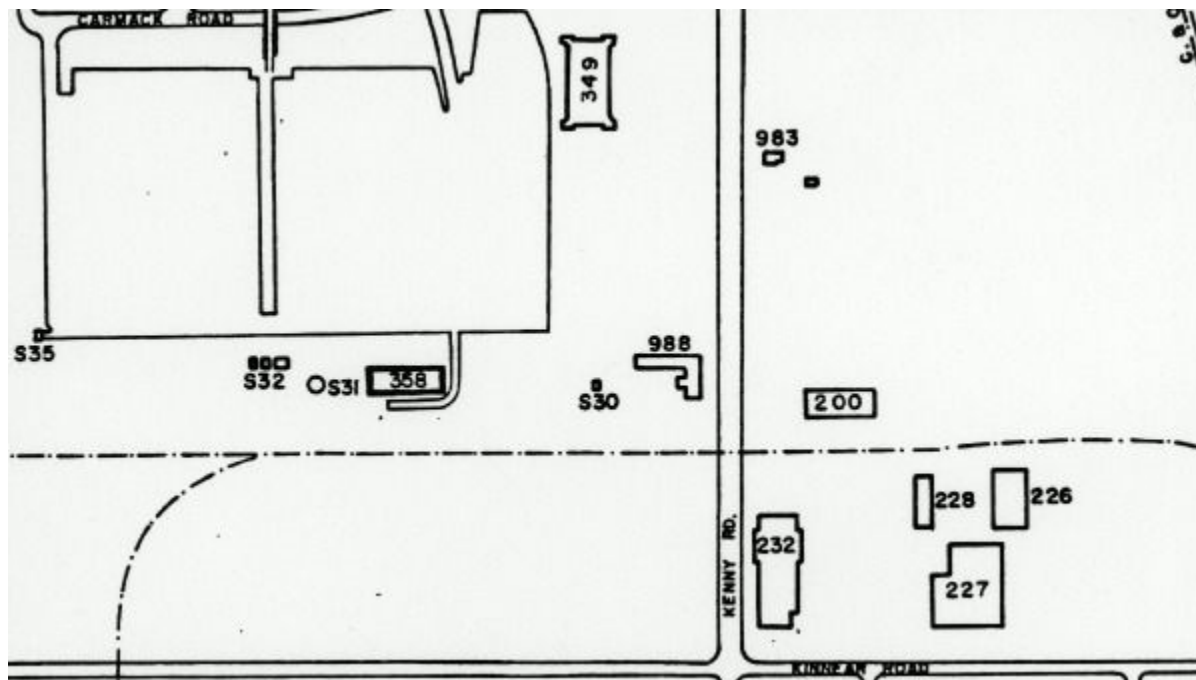

Wood frame and plywood exterior

3.2 No. of stories:

One story.

3.3 Increments of construction:

No additions.

B. PLANNING & CONSTRUCTION

Note: The building was constructed under contracts for the Hayes Hall Renovation. The following information applies to the total project.

1. On November 5, 1976 the Board of Trustees approved the plans and related documents prepared by Eschliman Associates and authorized the solicitation of bids by contractors.

2. Bids were received on April 15, 1977 and May 3, 1977 (T).

3. On May 6, 1977 the award of the following contracts was reported to the Board of Trustees:

General: Henry A. Justus, Incorporated

Electrical: Electric Power Equipment Company

Heating, ventilating, & air conditioning: Systems and Mechanical Contractors

Plumbing: Kirk Williams Company

4. Completion and occupancy:

Building 358 was released for beneficial occupancy effective December 20, 1977 (P), but inside work was still in progress.
