1.1 Built as "Antenna Laboratory." Name changed to "ElectroScience Laboratory" by Board of Trustees on June 8, 1967.

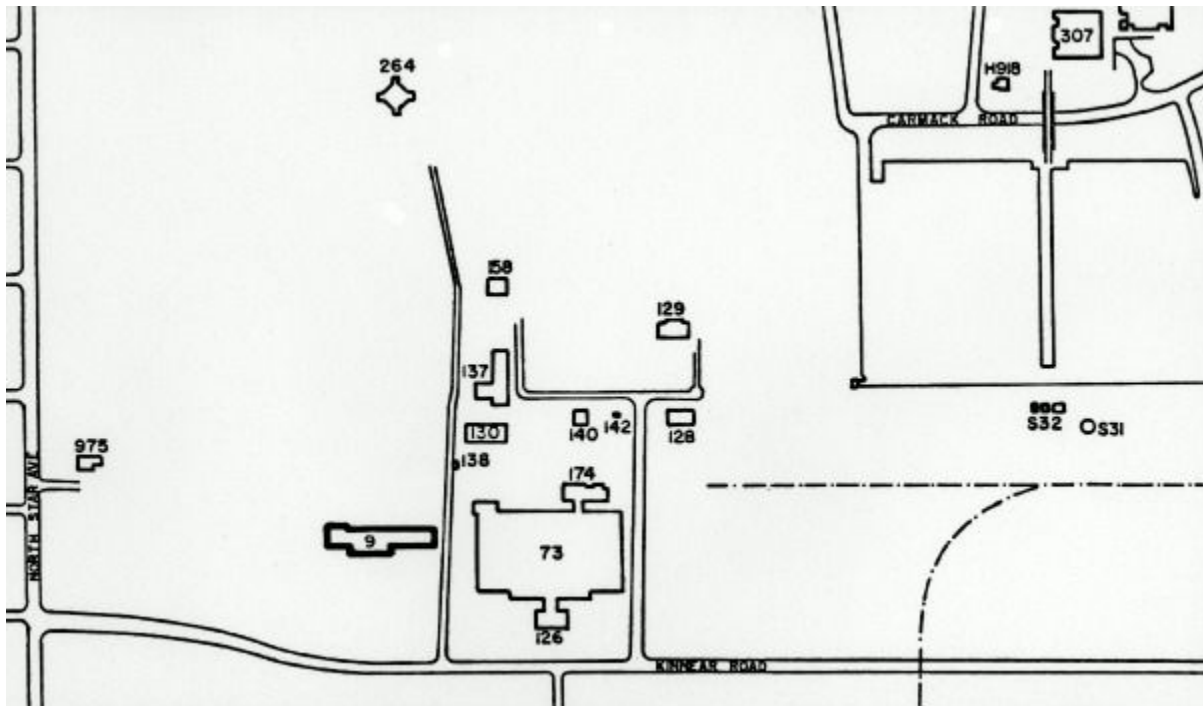
1.2 Alternate names noted:

### 3. General Description

3.1 Type of construction:

Reinforced concrete frame with concrete block exterior.

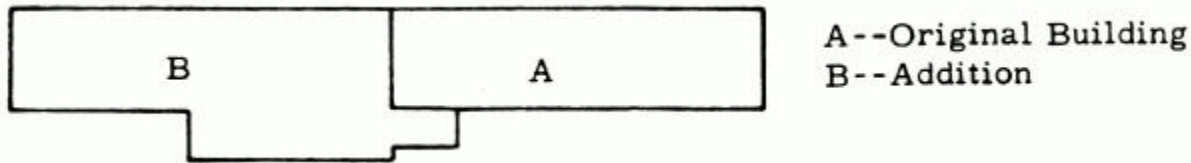
3.2 No. of stories:

Two and two small penthouses.

3.3 Increments of construction:

Enlarged once. See sketch.

## B. PLANNING & CONSTRUCTION--ORIGINAL BUILDING

1. On September 7, 1954 the Board of Trustees approved the plans and related documents prepared by Howard Dwight Smith and authorized the solicitation of bids by contractors.
2. Bids were received on December 7, 1954 (T).
3. On December 13, 1954 the Board of Trustees awarded contracts to the following contractors:
  - General: G. W. Atkinson & Son
  - Electrical: McCarty Bros. Electric Co.
  - Heating & ventilating: Limbach Co.
  - Plumbing: Linbach Co.
4. Completion and occupancy:
  - All contracts were substantially completed as of October 1, 1955 (A).

## ADDENDUM NO. 1

The Board of Trustees on February 4, 1983 approved plans for a storage room addition prepared by the University Architect's Office, and authorized the solicitation of bids and the awarding of contracts. On October 7, 1983 it was reported to the Board of Trustees that bids had been opened on this addition on August 17, 1983 and that the construction contract had been awarded to Concepts Enterprises in the amount of \$32,988.

Construction began in November 1983 (A) and the project was released for beneficial occupancy in January 1984. (A)

This addition is shown designated "C" in the following sketch.



Campus Planning records now show the following areas for the enlarged building:

26,440 sq. feet gross

17,579 sq. feet net assignable
