**TUITION-FREE COURSE TRAINS WOMEN
COLLEGE GRADUATES FOR GOVERNMENT
ENGINEERING POSITIONS**

the U. S. Civil Service Commission and the U. S. Office of Education have developed a short tuition-free course to train women college graduates for junior engineering positions paying an entrance salary of \$2,000 a year upon completion of the course which will be given at any institution offering engineering training. Provided there is a sufficient enrollment, the course may be given as a 10 week, full time, day course or as a 27 week evening course.
