POCKET RADIO TRANSMITTER

Heavy equipment, used in reporting news events via radio, has been replaced by a miniature, pocket size transmitter. Some of the difficulties met by the broadcasting reporter are decreased because of the light construction of the new midget set. Although the unit is housed in a three inch cube, and uses a wave length of only one meter, a pick up station, located anywhere within a four mile radius of the reporter, easily picks up his words for re-transmission.
