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Final Highlights of Enrollment for the Summer Quarter of 2001

August 10, 2001

Summer Quarter 2001 began on June 18, 2001. An official census for the quarter was conducted as of the close of processing on August 8. The fifteenth day census is the basis for these highlights and the supporting data contained therein.

- An overall decrease in enrollment of 31 students compared to Summer Quarter 2000 was recorded for this quarter. Increases were experienced at Lima (up 15 to 558, 2.8%), Marion (up 37 to 358, 11.5%) and Newark (up 33 to 702, 4.9%). Decreases of enrollment compared to Summer 2000 were experienced at Columbus (down 61 to 19,325, -0.3%), Mansfield (down 37 to 471, -7.3%) and Wooster (down 18 to 239, -7.0%). [Table 1]

- For the total university, the decrease in undergraduate enrollment (down 160 to 12,953, -1.2%) combined with the increases for graduate professional (up 35 to 1,038, 3.5%) and graduate enrollment (up 94 to 7,662, 1.2%) resulted in the overall enrollment decrease from Summer 2000. An increase in undergraduate enrollment was recorded for new first quarter freshmen (up 10 to 163, 6.5%). Decreases in undergraduate enrollment were recorded for transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (down 21 to 137, -13.3%), transfer students above Rank 2 (down 94 to 726, -11.5%), continuing students (down 44 to 10,929, -0.4%), and returning students (down 11 to 998, -1.1%). An overall decrease in undergraduate enrollment was recorded for the extended campuses as a whole (down 31 to 1,683, -1.8%). This was due to decreases in transfer students above Rank 2 (down 1 to 155, -0.6%), continuing student enrollment (down 45 to 1,272, -3.4%), and returning students (down 11 to 162, -6.4%) which outweighed the increases in new first quarter freshmen (up 14 to 66, 26.9%) and transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (up 12 to 28, 75.0%). An overall decrease in undergraduate enrollment was also recorded for the Columbus campus (down 129 to 11,270, -1.1%). This was due to decreases in new first quarter freshmen (down 4 to 97, -4.0%), transfer students in Ranks 1 & 2 (down 33 to 109, -23.2%), and transfer students above Rank 2 (down 93 to 571, -14.0%). Enrollment of continuing undergraduate students increased for Columbus campus (up 1 to 9,657, 0.0%) and there was no change in the number of returning undergraduates. Graduate student enrollment at all extended campuses increased (up 61 to 645, 10.4%). Overall enrollment of new graduate students is up 61 to 1041 (6.2%). Enrollment figures for continuing graduate students have increased (up 107 to 5,743, 1.9%). Enrollment of returning graduate students have decreased (down 74 to 878, -7.8%). Overall enrollment of graduate professional students is up 35 to 1,038 (3.5%). [Table 2]

- Beginning Summer 2001, Undergraduate Student Academic Services replaced University College as part of an effort to facilitate the University's move toward direct enrollment. Thus, seven undergraduate curricular programs at the Columbus campus saw increases in excess of ten percent. They are Arts and Sciences, Unknown (up 9 to 42, 27.3%), The Arts (up 78 to 425, 22.5%), Biological Sciences (up 47 to 460, 11.4%), Humanities (up 89 to 888, 11.1%), Business (up 282 to 1,129, 33.3%), Architecture (up 14 to 75, 23.0%), and Nursing (up 11 to 54, 25.6%). One undergraduate curricular program saw a decrease in excess of ten percent, Food, Agricultural, and Environmental Sciences (down 32 to 269, -10.6%). Eight graduate level programs recorded increases in excess of ten percent compared to Summer 2000: Journalism (up 3 to 27, 12.5%), Business (up 53 to 243, 27.9%), Architecture (up 19 to 72, 35.8%), Human Ecology (up 10 to 100, 11.1%), Allied Medical Professions (up 30 to 66, 83.8%), Nursing (up 23 to 130, 21.5%), Other Graduate Interdisciplinary (up 362 to 473, 326.1%), and Pharmacy (up 9 to 85, 11.8%). The graduate program in Medicine experienced a 23.7% increase (up 27 to 141) and program in Veterinary Medicine had a 21.3% increase compared to Summer 2000 (up 17 to 97). Three graduate level programs experienced a decrease in excess of ten percent: The Arts (down 39 to 297, -11.6%), Education (down 406 to 1,877, -17.8%), and Natural Resources (down 7 to 56, -11.1%). One graduate professional level program recorded a change (positive or negative) in excess of ten percent: Pharmacy (up 5 to 35, 16.7%). [Table 3 and Table 4]
- Credits generated by full-time undergraduates decreased both at Columbus (down 320 to 68,016, -0.5%) and the extended campuses as a whole (down 351 to 6,149, -5.4%) for a combined decrease of 671 to 74,165 (-0.9%) compared to Summer Quarter 2000. Credits for part-time undergraduate students decreased at Columbus (down 12 to 42,712, 0.0%) and increased at the extended campuses as a whole (up 69 to 8,235, 0.8%) for a combined increase of 57 to 50,947 (0.1%) compared to Summer Quarter 2000. Full-time and part-time undergraduate credit decreases combine for a total decrease of 614 to 125,112 (-0.5%) for the entire university. Undergraduate credit hour decreases were due to overall headcount decreases and credits attempted per student throughout the university increased slightly (up 0.07 to 9.66, 0.7%) compared to Summer 2000. At the graduate level, there was an overall increase in credits (up 3,138 to 73,163, 4.5%). This increase is due to increases in credits at the Columbus campus (up 2,452 to 68,315, 3.7%) and at the extended campuses as a whole (up 686 to 4848, 16.5%). Graduate credits per student are also up 3.2%. Graduate professional credits are down by 29.6% (down 5.64 to 13.43) resulting from a decrease of 5,189 credits to 13,945 (-27.1%). Undergraduate FTE decreased from 8,382 to 8,341. Graduate professional FTE decreased from 1,276 to 930. Graduate FTE increased from 4,668 to 4,878. [Table 5]
- For the total university one county experienced an enrollment change in excess of forty percent (positive or negative), Fulton (down 43.8%). At Columbus, the counties that recorded enrollment changes in excess of forty percent (positive or negative) from Summer 2000 are: Fulton (down 40.0%) and Morgan (up 133.3%). [Table 6 and Table 7]
- For the total university, the following states and territories recorded enrollment changes in excess of forty percent from last Summer: Hawaii (up 66.7%), South Dakota (down 42.9%), Mississippi (up 57.1%), New Hampshire (down 58.8%), Montana (up 300.0%), and Virgin Islands (up 100.0%). At Columbus, the states and territories with enrollment that changed in excess of forty percent from last Summer are: Hawaii (up 66.7%), Mississippi (up 42.9%), New Hampshire (down 58.8%), Virgin Islands (up 100.0%), Montana (up 300.0%), and South Dakota (down 42.9%). - Of the twenty-five countries with the largest representation of students enrolled at Ohio State, India (up 31.0%), Turkey (up 20.5%), Hong Kong (up 26.7%), Germany (up 42.1%), England (down 27.6%), Malaysia (down 44.7%), Pakistan (up 31.3%), Spain (up 41.7%), Brazil (up 55.6%), and United Arab Emirates (up 600.0%) recorded changes in enrollment in excess of twenty percent from Summer Quarter 2000 . People's Republic of China, Republic of Korea, India, Indonesia, Taiwan, and Japan recorded enrollment of 100 or more students this quarter. [Table 10]
- Undergraduate curricular academic programs with international student enrollment in excess of five percent are Arts and Sciences, General (8.9%), Mathematical and Physical Sciences (5.4%), Business (15.7%), Engineering (14.5%), and Social Work (9.1%). Continuing Education has an international enrollment of 12.0 percent and Undergraduate Student Academic Services has an international enrollment of 8.4 percent. Undergraduate international enrollment for the total university is 785, 1 at the extended campuses, 784 at the Columbus campus. Forty percent or more of the graduate students in Biological Sciences (44.7%), Journalism (63.0%), Mathematical and Physical Sciences (50.4%), Engineering (71.8%), Food, Agricultural & Environmental Sciences (45.7%), Pharmacy (45.9%) and the graduate program in Veterinary Medicine (45.4%) are international students. [Table 11]
- Summer 2001 recorded an all-time high enrollment for Summer Quarter among Hispanic students (381 total, 358 Columbus campus). There was a record high enrollment of 480 female professional students and there were also an all-time high enrollments of 9 international professional students and 1,897 international graduate students. [Tables 12, 13, and 14]
- At the undergraduate level, enrollment decreases were recorded for Ohio residents (down 104 to 11,298, -0.9%), and not-Ohio residents (down 56 to 1,655, -3.3%). At the graduate level an enrollment decrease was recorded for Ohio residents (down 138 to 4,613, -2.9%) and an enrollment increase was recorded for not-Ohio residents (up 232 to 3,049, 8.2%). Graduate professional enrollment of Ohio residents increased 42 to 994 (up 4.4%) and not-Ohio residents decreased 7 to 44 (down 13.7%). [Table 15]
