MANUSCRIPTS: *The Ohio Journal of Science* considers original contributions and invited reviews based on investigations of current scientific interest. Special consideration will be given to short papers (no more than six double-spaced type-written pages) and Ohioiana. All papers will be critically reviewed and are subject to the approval of the Editorial Committee. It should be understood that the opinions expressed by the reviewers are their own and do not represent the views of the *Ohio Journal of Science* or of the Ohio Academy of Science.

An original and one copy of each manuscript must be submitted to the Editor. An additional copy of the paper should be retained by the author for reference. The title page should indicate the mailing address of the individual to whom correspondence should be addressed. Galley proof, engraver's proof and the original manuscript will be returned to the author for final approval of the materials as set. See past numbers of the *Journal* and the *Style Manual for Biological Journals* for detailed instructions on the preparation of manuscripts.

REPRINTS: A price list for reprints and an order form are sent with the galley proofs. Authors should allow about 60 days after publication for receipt of reprints.

SUBSCRIPTIONS: Annual subscription \$15.00 (foreign countries, \$16.50). Single numbers for Academy members \$3.00; for non-members \$3.50. Single volumes (six numbers): \$18.00; runs of ten or more volumes: \$16.00 per volume. Discounts are available for bulk subscriptions. Issued bimonthly, January to November, six issues per volume. *The Ohio Journal of Science* is sent to subscribers and to all paid-up members of The Ohio Academy of Science.
